Overview of SoftChalk Cloud

To quickly get started with SoftChalk Cloud, please see our [SoftChalk Cloud Quick Start Guide](#).

SoftChalk Cloud (<https://softchalkcloud.com>) is an eLearning content authoring platform in the cloud. [SoftChalk Cloud](#) encompasses a:

- Public content repository ([SoftChalk Share](#))
- Content authoring program ([SoftChalk Create](#))
- Hosting service
- ScoreCenter (a score tracking feature available [within your learning management system](#) and [outside a learning management system](#))

From the [SoftChalk Cloud](#) **SoftChalk Share** tab, the public can search the **SofChalk Share** content repository by grade level and subject. (See the section [SoftChalk Share](#).) The types of content available include learning activities such as crossword puzzles, quiz groups such as multiple choice questions and multi-page lessons. **You can copy hyperlinks or the embed code for this content.** You can even have an Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud for your institution (see the section [Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud for Institutions](#)).

The use of this content is determined by the Creative Commons license for the content. See the section [Creative Commons Licenses](#).

While the public can search the **SofChalk Share** content repository and copy hyperlinks and embed code to content there, you can have many more features available to you with a SoftChalk Cloud account. See the next section [Features of a SoftChalk Cloud Account](#).

You can create a **free 30-day trial account** and try out the features of a SoftChalk Cloud account. Click the **Join Now** button in the upper right on the home page of [SoftChalk Cloud](#). If you decide later to subscribe, you do NOT need to create a new account (even if your account has expired). You can enter an activation key and keep your same username and account (see the sections [Purchase a SoftChalk Cloud Account](#) and [Subscribe](#)).

Save your content to the SoftChalk Cloud – see the section SoftChalk Create - Develop eLearning Content . (Space limit is 2 gigabytes – to purchase additional space, contact sales@softchalk.com)
Update Your Lesson Once But Link to the Lesson in Many Places	Update your lesson once but link to the lesson in many places such as multiple courses within your learning management system. See the sections Copy the Hyperlink for Your Lesson and Copy the LTI Link for Your Lesson . Below are the general steps: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Create a lesson with SoftChalk Create and save it in SoftChalk Cloud.○ Copy the Hyperlink (or LTI Link if you are integrating the lesson with your learning management system gradebook)○ Paste the Hyperlink or LTI Link in your courses. Put Your Content in the SoftChalk Share Public Content Repository	See the sections SoftChalk Share , Privacy Options , Save a Learning Object or Quiz Group to the Cloud and Save a Lesson to the Cloud .

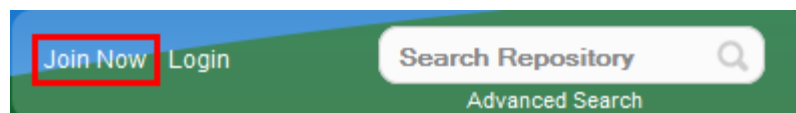

1. Go to the [SoftChalk Cloud](https://softchalkcloud.com) website (<https://softchalkcloud.com>).

2. At the top right, click **Join Now**.



3. Select the **Account Type**. Select the type of account you want. Fill out your information and click **Join** at the bottom of the screen.



If you want to make your other information private as well, see the section [Manage Your Account](#).

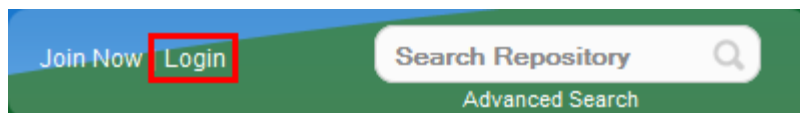



Log into Your Account

1. Go to the [SoftChalk Cloud](https://softchalkcloud.com) website (<https://softchalkcloud.com>).
2. At the top right, click **Login**.



3. Enter your username and password and click **Login**.

Purchase a SoftChalk Cloud Account

A SoftChalk Cloud account is available as a yearly subscription. You can purchase a SoftChalk Cloud account in two ways (via credit card or through your institution) – see the next two sections.

Purchase Now (Submit Credit Card Info)

If you already have a **free 30-day trial account**, you can subscribe at any time to a yearly account. Even if your account expires, you can log into it and subscribe. See the section [Subscribe](#).

If you are creating a **new SoftChalk Cloud account**, you can purchase a SoftChalk Cloud account (see the section [Create an Account](#)).

As soon as you purchase your SoftChalk Cloud account online with a credit card, it is available (i.e. you don't need to enter an activation key).

I Have an Activation Key (Purchased Through My Institution)

Your institution can purchase SoftChalk Cloud accounts (with an activation key) for one or more users.

IMPORTANT: If you want to take advantage of a **volume purchase** or you use **purchase orders** as your method of payment, please contact sales@softchalk.com.

IMPORTANT: Please note that the SoftChalk Cloud Activation Key is NOT the same as a desktop SoftChalk Create License Key. (The desktop SoftChalk Create License Key consists of two parts and is entered through the Help menu within the desktop application.)

If your institution purchased a SoftChalk Cloud Activation Key (for one or multiple users) and **you received an Activation Key via email from SoftChalk (or from someone at your institution who forwarded the information)**, then you can enter this SoftChalk Cloud Activation Key:

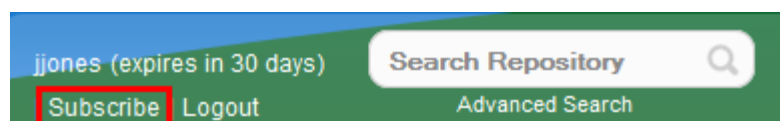
- If you already have a trial account, log into your account. (You do NOT need to create a new account.) In the upper right corner, click **Subscribe** and enter your Activation Key. (For details, see the section [Subscribe](#) OR
- Create a new account (see the section [Create an Account](#))

IMPORTANT: As mentioned previously, if you already have a free trial account, you can subscribe by logging into your current trial account. **You do NOT have to create a new account.** For information on purchasing a SoftChalk Cloud account, see the previous section [Purchase a SoftChalk Cloud Account](#).

1. Log into your SoftChalk Cloud trial account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Once you are logged in, at the top right corner of your screen, click the **Subscribe** link (see below) and complete the information.

If you are logged in and you do NOT see the **Subscribe** link (see below), then you have already entered your activation key for your account.



- From the **Account Type** dropdown menu, select the appropriate option - either **Purchase Now** or **I have an activation key**.

As mentioned previously, the **Purchase Now** option allows you to purchase online via credit card and the **I have an activation key** option allows you to enter an activation key that was purchased by your institution (and sent via email from SoftChalk to the purchaser at your institution).

IMPORTANT: If you select *I have an activation key, this key is NOT the same as your desktop SoftChalk Create license key*. A SoftChalk Cloud Account (which includes SoftChalk Create) is a separate purchase from the desktop SoftChalk Create purchase.

Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud for Institutions

Advantages of an Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud

- Private centralized institutional repository for shared content/media
- Institution maintains administrative control of platform content assets
- Features for institutional branding and customizing of the platform
- Management of “permission groups” with varied rights and space allocation that can be modified for each group
- User management via password resets and the ability to view the site as a specific user to troubleshoot user issues
- Institutional control of storage space assignment to users
- Ability to monitor feedback received through the site
- May be integrated with campus single sign on service (see below)

Single Sign-on Login

Some of our Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud institutions are using a single-sign on feature. In other words, the logins for their Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud are integrated through the school’s login portal, allowing faculty and users to access their Enterprise SoftChalk Cloud with the same account name and login credentials that they use for other school services.

SoftChalk Create - Develop eLearning Content

SoftChalk Create is a content authoring program that is easy to use (like a word processor) but allows you to make your lessons engaging and interactive for your students. You can put various activities and quiz groups into your lessons. (See the section [Types of Content](#).)

SoftChalk Create is part of your subscription [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account.

(In addition to SoftChalk Create, you also have a feature called Create Online that is part of your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account. Create Online allows you to make quick text edits to your lesson. For details, please see the section [Create Online](#).)

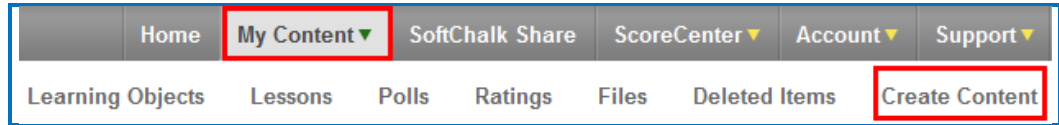

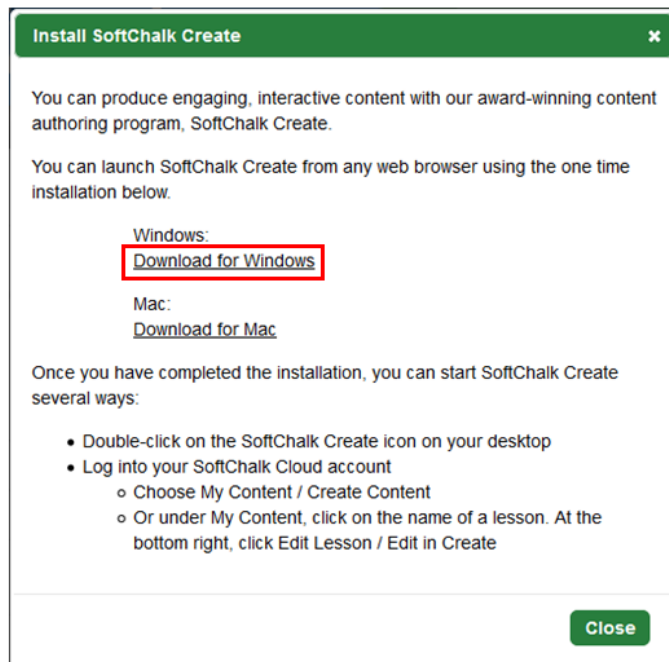

Install SoftChalk Create for Windows

1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Click on **My Content** and select **Create Content**.



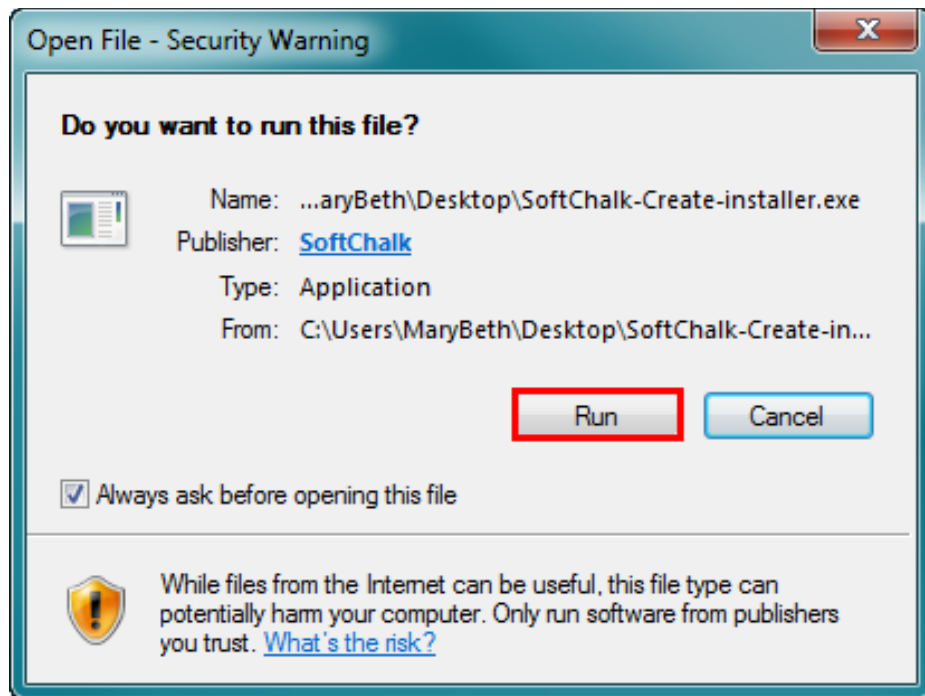
3. Click on the Windows download link (see below). Please be sure to let the download finish. The installation time is typically less than five minutes.



4. Open the folder where you downloaded your installer file. Typically, this folder is called **Downloads** on a Windows computer. The installer file is called **SoftChalk-Create-installer.exe**
5. Drag the installer file to your desktop and double-click on it (see below).



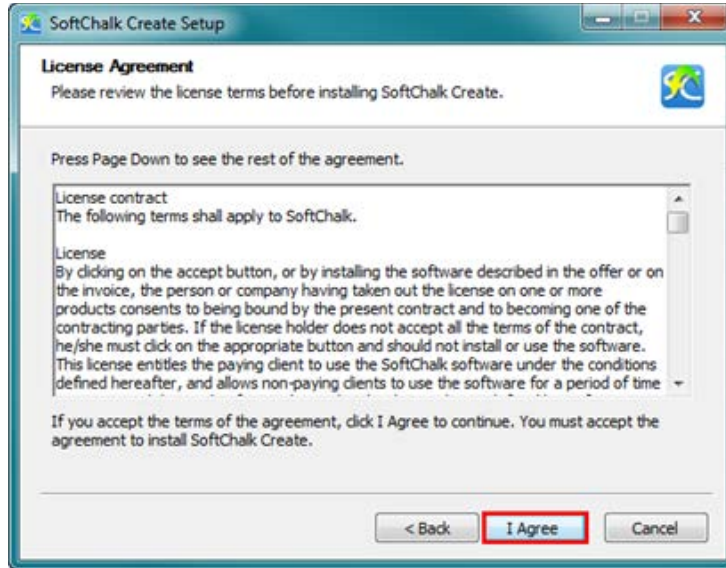
6. Click **Run** when the file first opens (see below).



7. Click **Next** at the initial setup screen.

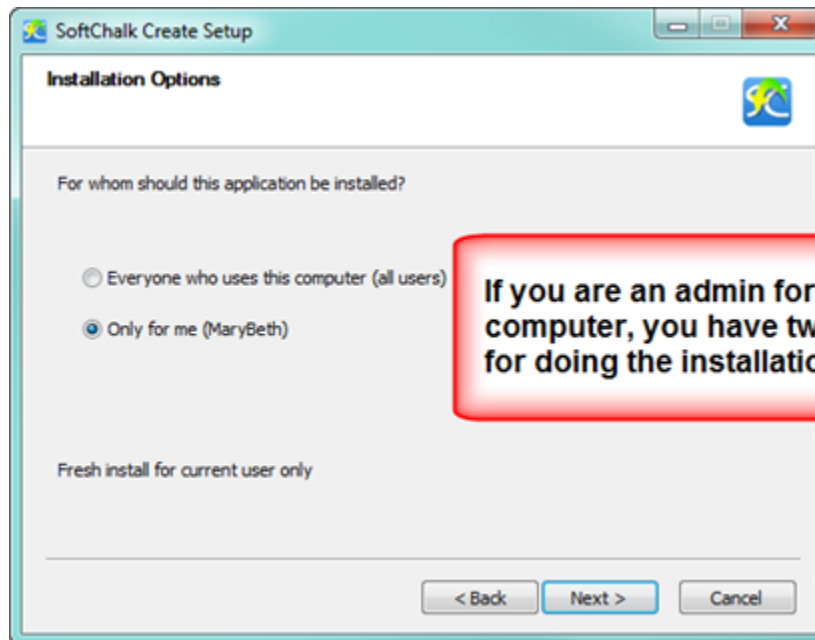


8. At the License Agreement screen, click **I Agree**.

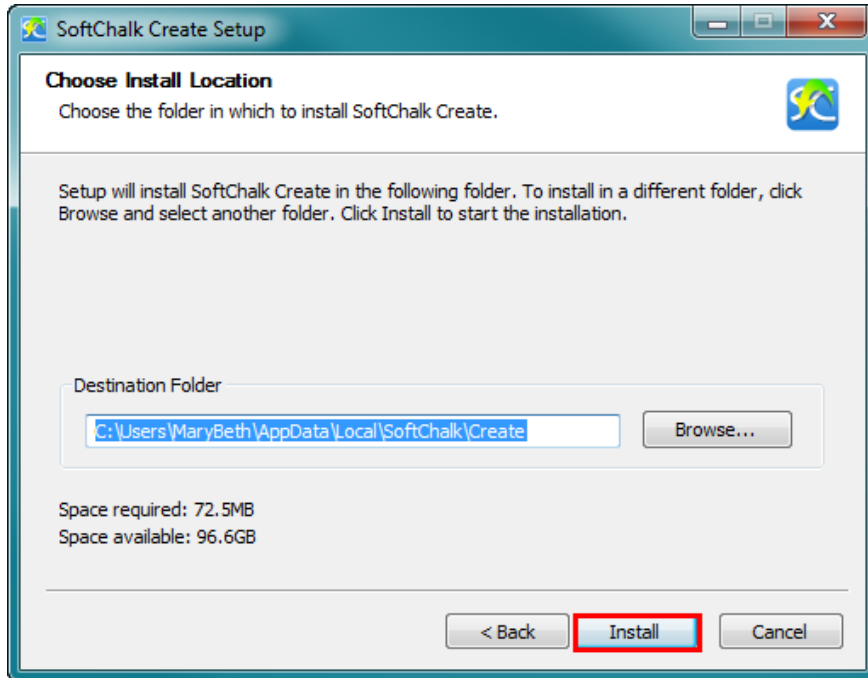


9. If you are an administrator, you have two options: 1) you can install SoftChalk Create for all users on the computer or 2) you can install SoftChalk Create for only your profile. Choose for whom the application should be installed and click **Next**. If you are an administrator for your computer and the first option is grayed out or you have trouble installing, right-click on the installer program on your desktop (blue SoftChalk icon) and choose **Run as Administrator**.

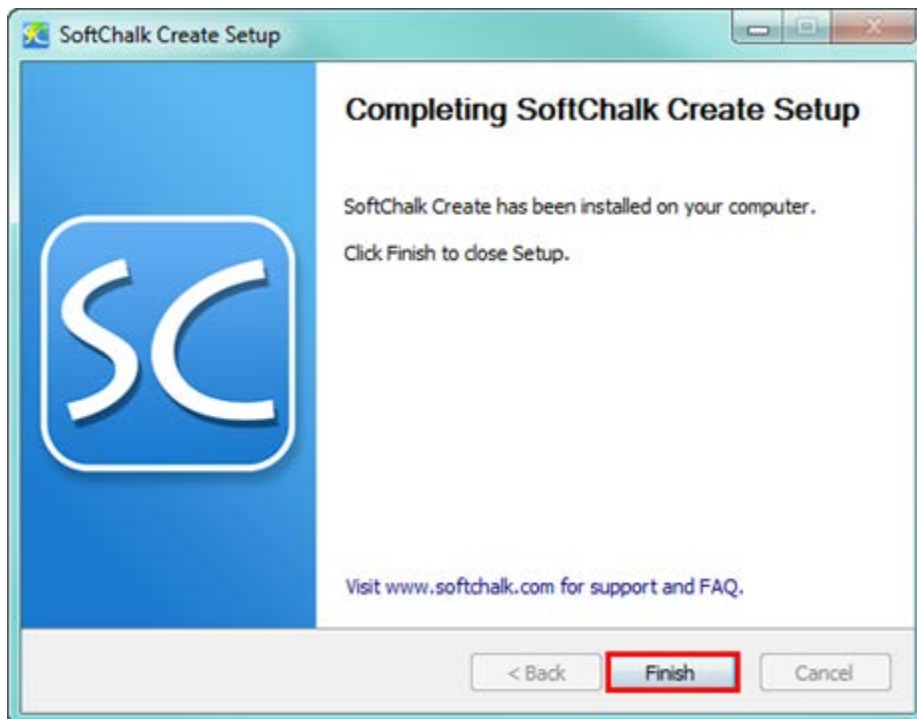
If you are NOT an administrator, you can only install for your user profile on the computer – the **Only for me** option. Click **Next**.



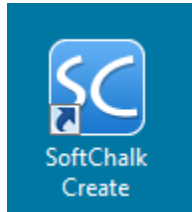
10. Click **Install**. For the single user profile installation, the application will be installed in C:\Users\USERNAME\AppData\Local\SoftChalk\Create. (If you are an admin installing for all users, the location would be C:\Program Files\SoftChalk\Create.)



11. Click **Finish** when the installation is complete.



12. Once you finish installing, you will see a shortcut on your desktop called ***SoftChalk Create***.

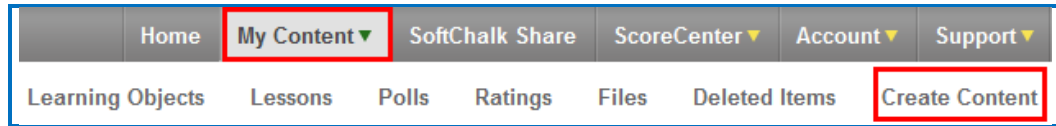

4. On your desktop, double-click on the **SoftChalk-Create.dmg** file (see below).



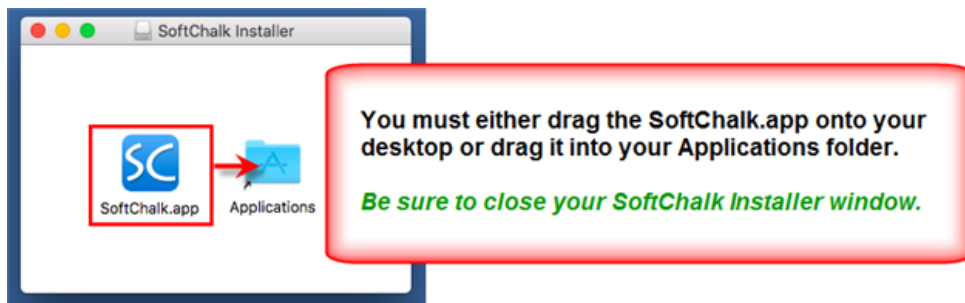
5. Double-click on the SoftChalk Installer icon (see below) and proceed to the next step.



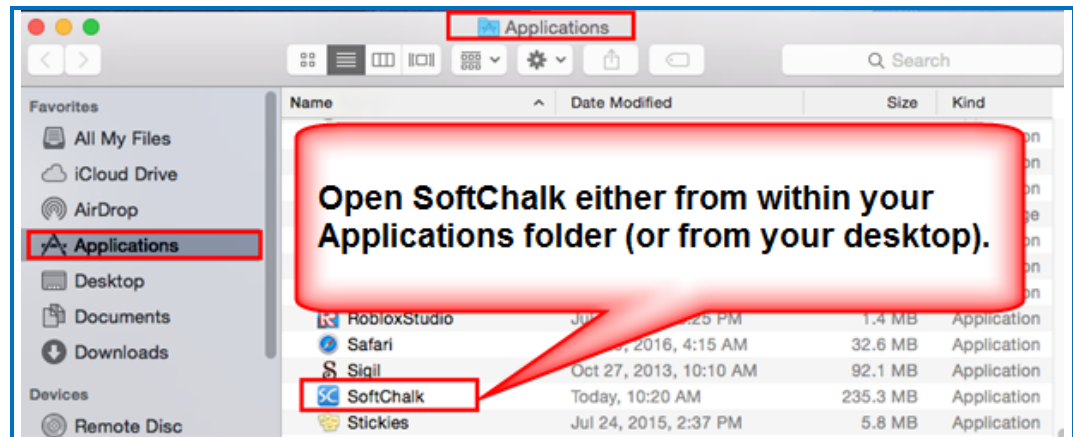
If you do NOT see the SoftChalk Installer icon above on your desktop, then see the solutions below:

- a. Please open your computer icon, typically **Macintosh HD**. Then look at the left hand column under **Devices**, and click on **SoftChalk Installer** and continue with Step 6 below.
 - b. If you do NOT see the SoftChalk Installer icon under the **Devices** area, then you may be using a non-standard program to open .dmg files. Control-click on the SoftChalk-Create.dmg file. Choose **Open with** and make sure that **DiskImageMounter.app** is the selected application.
6. You'll see the SoftChalk.app and the Applications folder (see below).

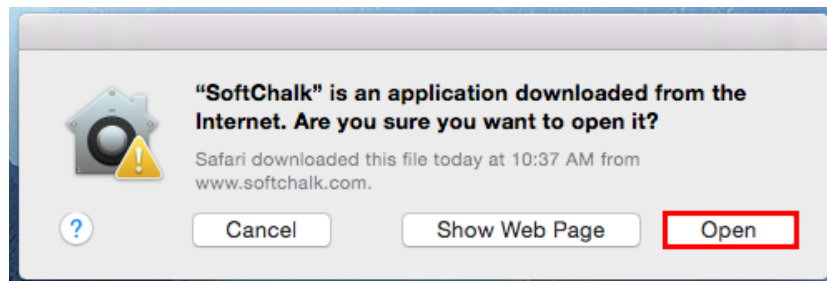
IMPORTANT: You must either drag the SoftChalk.app onto your desktop or drag it into your Applications folder. *Be sure to close your SoftChalk Installer window.*



- Open your Applications folder. Double-click on **SoftChalk** within your Applications folder (see below) or on your desktop (NOT within the SoftChalk Installer area shown previously).



- Click **Open** at the screen asking if you want to open this application downloaded from the Internet (see below).



- You can start Create from SoftChalk.app. See the section [Start SoftChalk Create from Your Desktop Shortcut](#). If you ever need to remove the login information from your computer, see the section [Deregister Your Login from Your Computer](#).
- You can also start Create from within your SoftChalk Cloud account. See the section [Start SoftChalk Create Within Your Cloud Account](#).


If you get an error **Unable to establish WebLaunchParams: 1 SoftChalk will close**, then you omitted the step of putting your SoftChalk.app into your Applications folder or dragging it onto your desktop. **Close your SoftChalk Installer window**. If you put it in your Applications folder, then start it from that folder. If you dragged it to your desktop, then start it from there. If the error persists, re-start your Macintosh and double-click on SoftChalk.app.

Start SoftChalk Create from Your Desktop Shortcut

1. Double-click on the SoftChalk Create shortcut on your desktop.
2. The first time you use the SoftChalk Create desktop shortcut, you will be required to register with your Cloud username and password. Once you fill in the information for your username and password, the **Register** button will become active.

IMPORTANT: If you have an *Enterprise Cloud account*, be sure to click **My account is with an Enterprise Cloud** and enter your URL.

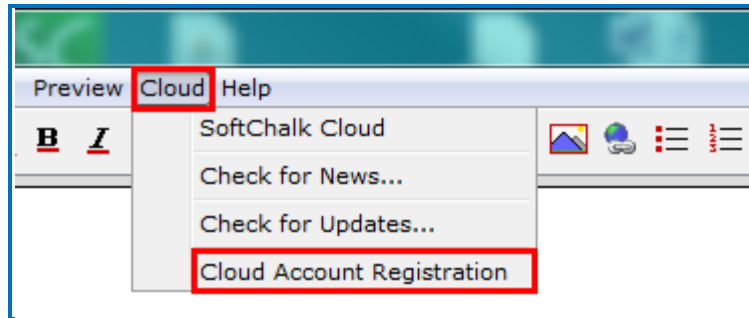

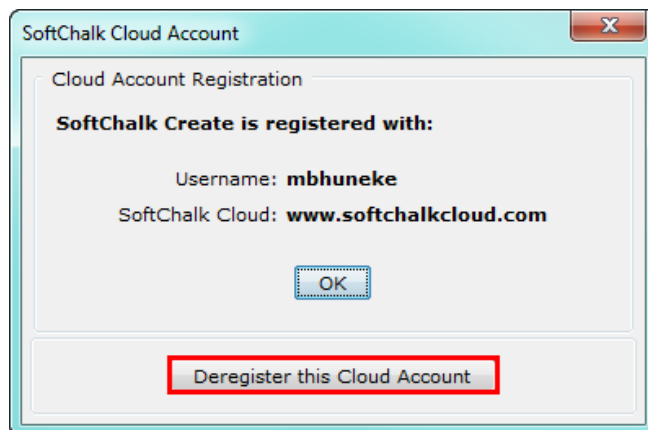
- In either case, you have the option to save your lessons to your local computer and then save them back to the Cloud later if you so choose.
- If you work online, you can open your Cloud lessons from the **File** menu, choosing **Open from SoftChalk Cloud**.
- If you work offline, certain features will not be available that require Internet access such as the Media Search tool.

Deregister Your Login from Your Computer

1. If you ever need to *deregister your information from a certain computer*, please do the following:
 - **Windows** –Start the **SoftChalk Create** desktop shortcut.
 - **Macintosh** - Start **SoftChalk**
2. Under the **Cloud** menu at the top left of your screen, choose **Cloud Account Registration**. If you do NOT see the Cloud Account Registration option, then you started Create from within your Cloud account rather than from your desktop.



3. Click **Deregister this Cloud Account**. Then click OK at the confirmation screen asking if you want to remove the account login information from your computer.



If you ever need to *change the username and password* in your SoftChalk Create program, please:

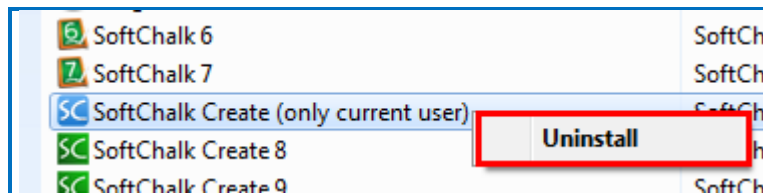
- Deregister your Cloud account with the computer (see the previous steps)
- Once you deregister the Cloud account, the empty registration screen will appear allowing you to enter a new username and password.

Uninstall SoftChalk Create

IMPORTANT: If you uninstall SoftChalk Create from your computer, be sure to first deregister your account from the computer. See the section [Deregister Your Login from Your Computer](#).

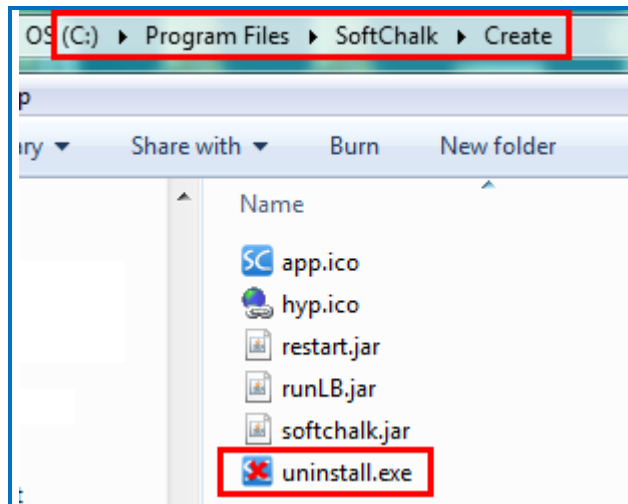
Windows - Uninstall for the Current User

1. Go to the Control Panel.
2. Select **Programs and Features**.
3. Right-click on **SoftChalk Create** and select **Uninstall**.



Windows - Admin – Uninstall for All Users

1. Go into the folder **C:\Program Files\SoftChalk\Create**
2. Run the file **uninstall.exe**



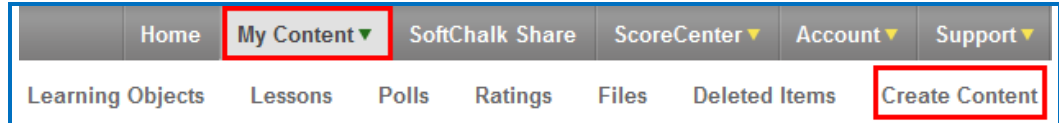

- Drag the SoftChalk icon into the trash and empty the trash.

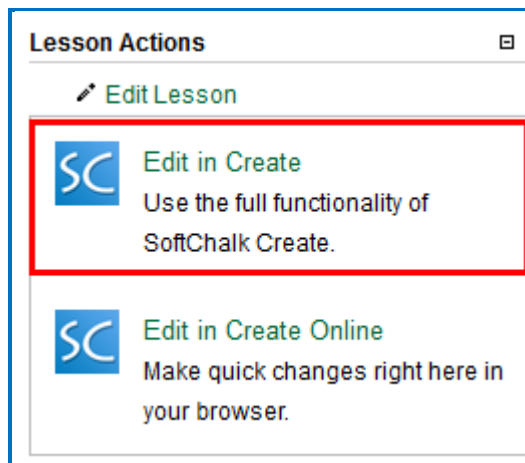


3. Please note when you first start SoftChalk Create from your web browser, you will see a one time message. See the section [Web Browsers – One Time Message](#).

Edit an Existing Lesson

If you have already saved a lesson to your Cloud account, you can quickly edit a particular lesson.

1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Choose **My Content / Lessons**.
3. Click on the name of a lesson.
4. At the bottom right in the **Lesson Actions** area, click **Edit Lesson / Edit in Create**. Please note when you first start SoftChalk Create from your web browser, you will see a one time message. See the section [Web Browsers – One Time Message](#).

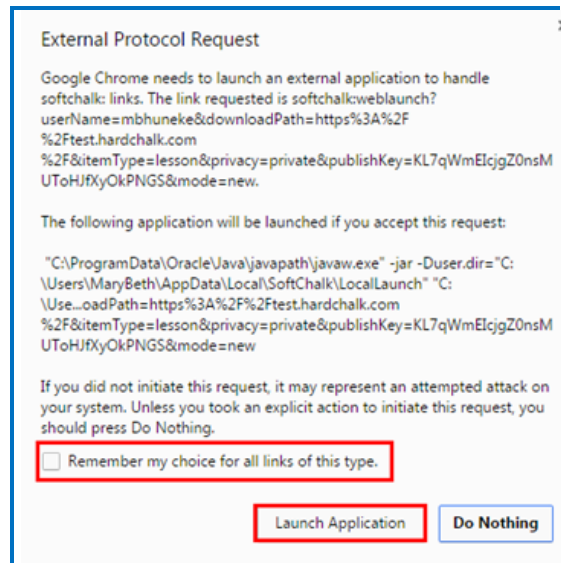


Web Browsers - One Time Message

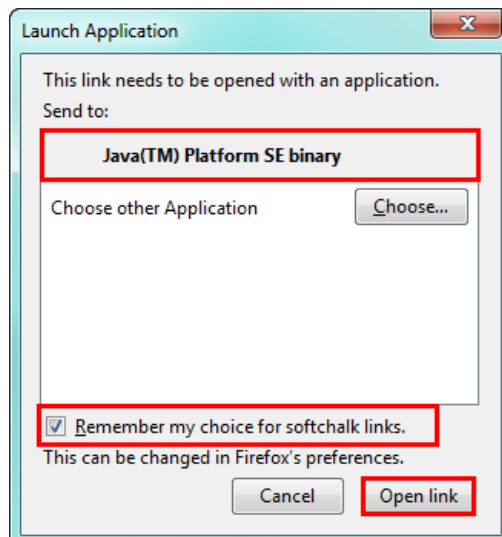

Select **Remember my choice for all links of this type** and click **Launch Application**.



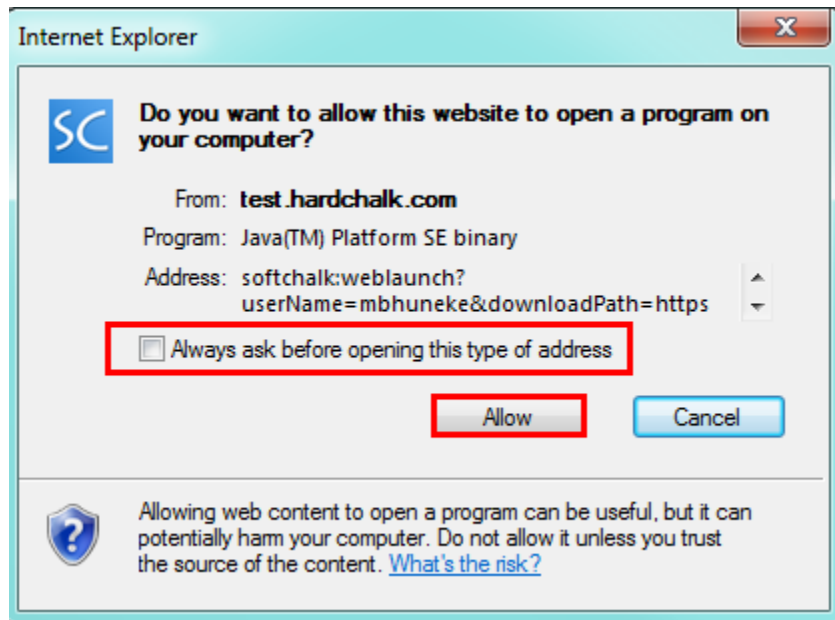

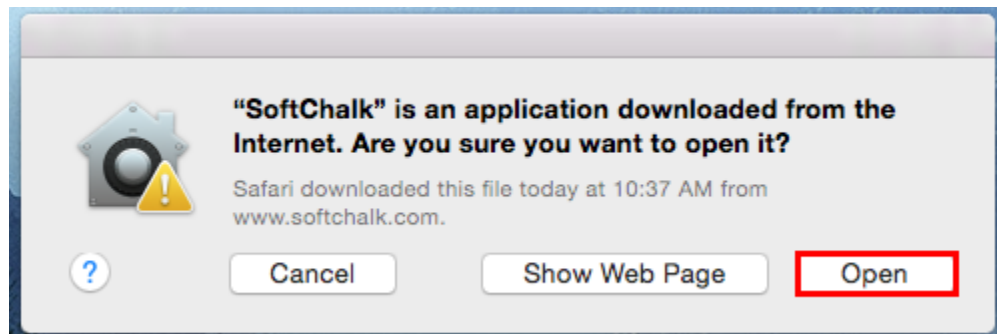

Save Content to the Cloud – My Content

As you produce content with SoftChalk Create, you can save your content locally on your computer or within your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (or have your content in both places). For instance, you may choose to save your content on your computer and then save it to SoftChalk Cloud. At any time you can download your content from SoftChalk Cloud.

There are many advantages of saving your content within your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account:

- You have automatic backups and you can go back to five previous versions of your item. See the section [Select a Previous Version of Your Content](#).
- Your content is available within the Cloud, so you can log into your account and work on it anywhere.
- You can easily collaborate with other instructors. See the section [Collaborate with Other Instructors on SoftChalk Lessons](#).
- You can update your lesson in one place but post a link to your lesson in many places. See the sections [Copy the Hyperlink for Your Lesson](#) or [Copy the LTI Link for Your Lesson](#).

When you save your content in your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account, the content goes into your **My Content** area. (If **My Content** is disabled, be sure to log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account.) See the next section [Types of Content](#) for an explanation of the different sections under **My Content**.

Types of Content

With [SoftChalk Create](#), you can develop content that you save in SoftChalk Cloud in the **My Content** area.



You can develop learning objects (also referred to as activities), quiz groups and lessons. You can also insert media such as images and into a lesson and then save that content to your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account under **My Content/Files** (see the section [Save Content to Files](#)). See the following table for a summary of the types of content you can have in your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account and where this content is stored. For more instructions on using [SoftChalk Create](#) to develop content, see the [SoftChalk Create Guide](#) and the **Getting Started** section within this guide.

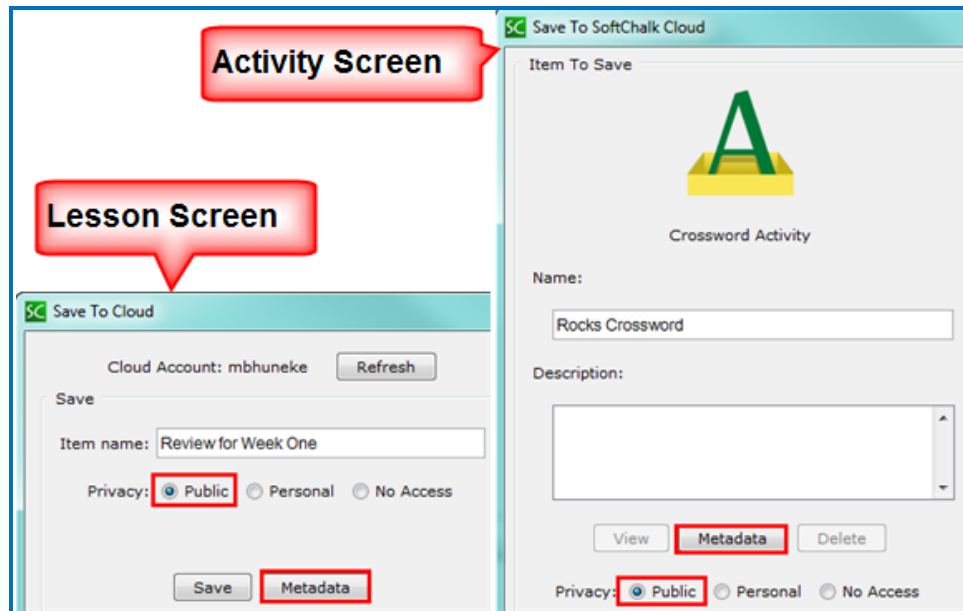
Privacy Options

When you save your content into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account, you have three privacy options. You designate the privacy option when you save your content (see the next sections [Save a Learning Object or Quiz Group to the Cloud](#) and [Save a Lesson to the Cloud](#)). You can also change the privacy option once you save it in your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account. You can resave your lesson with a different privacy option. Or you can edit the property in the Cloud - see the section [View, Edit Properties and Delete Your Content](#).

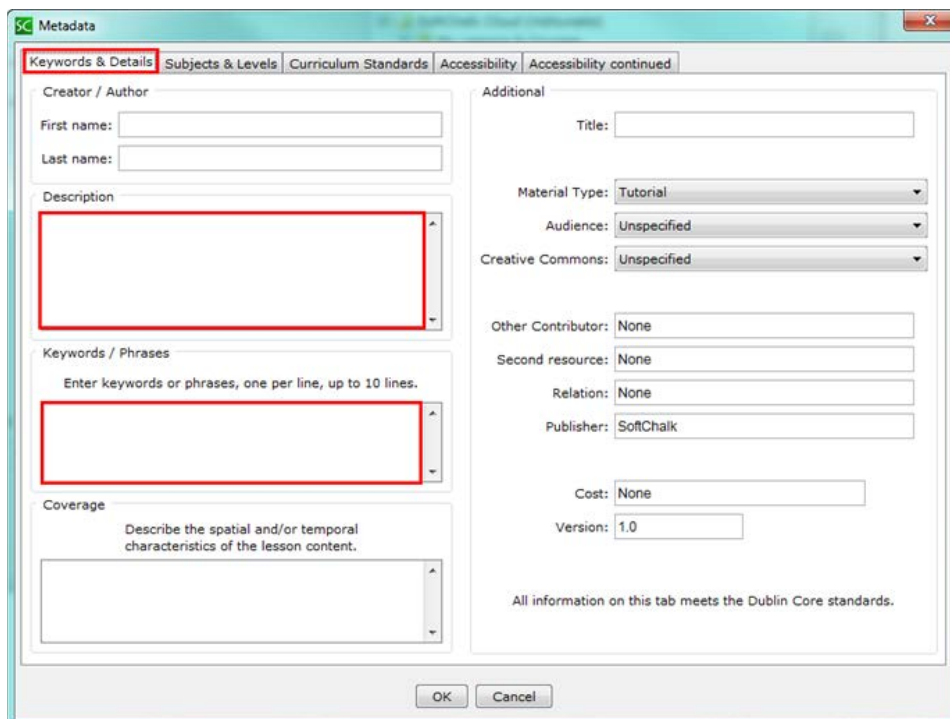
Privacy Option	Description
Public	Anyone can find your item in the SoftChalk Share content repository and copy the Embed code or Hyperlink for it and/or copy your content to modify it. If you make your content public, see the next section Assign Metadata to Public Content . You can attach a Creative Commons license to your content (see the section Creative Commons Licenses).
Private	The item is NOT searchable in the SoftChalk Share content repository. (You, however, can find the Embed code or Hyperlink and pass it out to students or colleagues within a learning management system or outside a learning management system.)
No Access	There is no hyperlink or embed code for your item. Only you (or others who share access to your content folders) can view or edit the item.

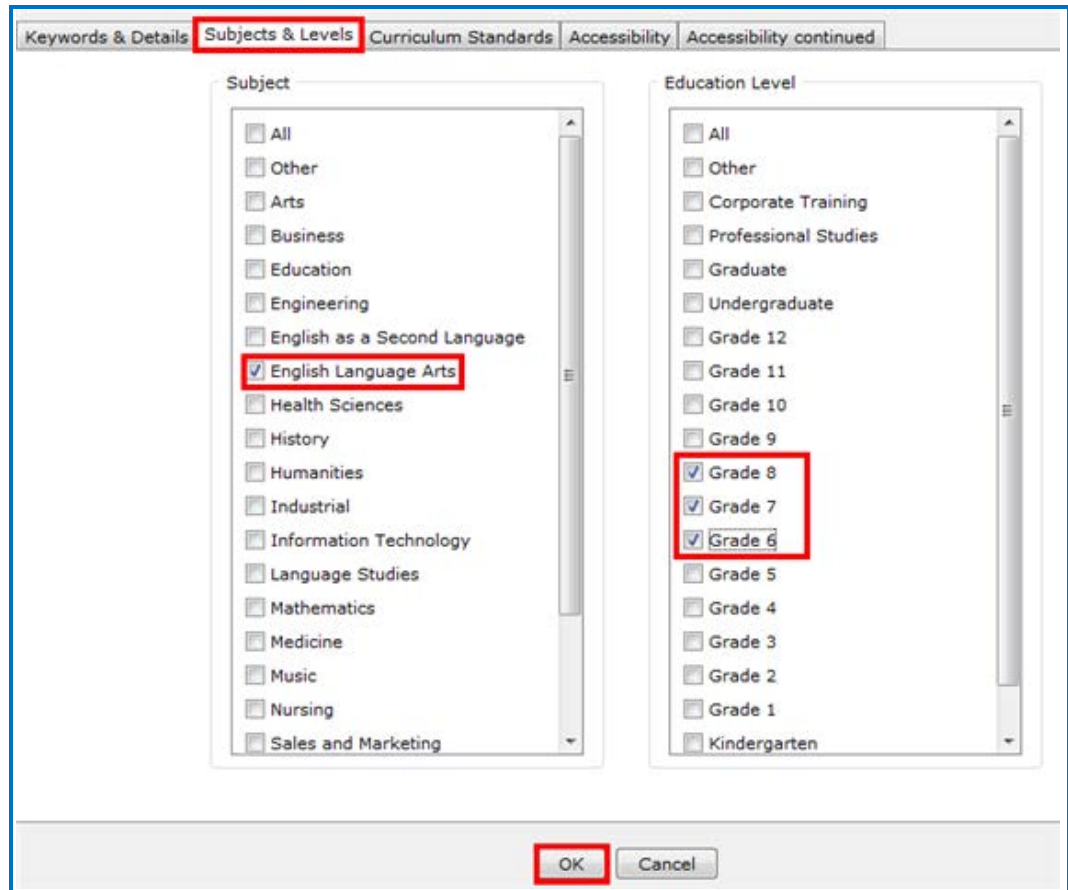
1. If you selected **Public** for your Privacy option when saving content to SoftChalk Cloud, you'll need to enter a description, subject and education level for your item or lesson. Click the **Metadata** button.



2. Click the **Keywords & Details** tab. Enter a description. *We also recommend that you enter keywords* so that your content can be found in the [SoftChalk Share Search Repository](#) field where users search for content.



3. Click the **Subjects & Levels** tab. Select one or more **Subjects** and **Education Levels** and click **OK**.

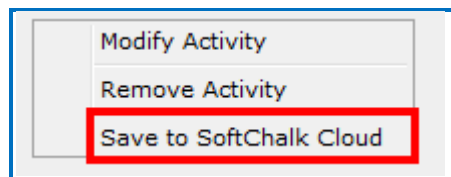

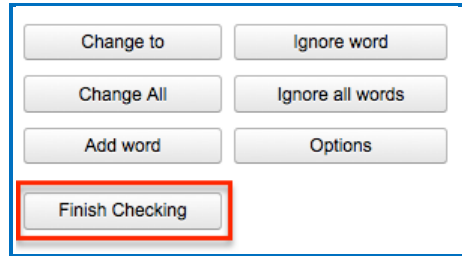


- If a word is identified as misspelled, but the spelling is appropriate for your document (such as an acronym, abbreviation or proper name), click **Ignore** in order to ignore it this one time, or click **Ignore all words** to ignore it each time it is used in this document.

5. Click **Finish Checking** to save your spell check actions.



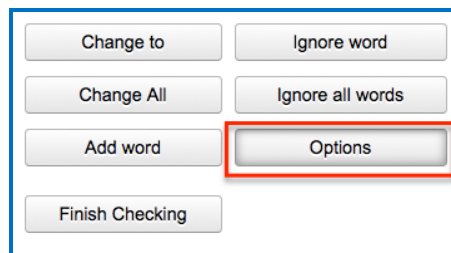
Add a Word – Save a Word to Your Browser’s Cookies

If a word is identified as misspelled, but the spelling is appropriate for your document (such as an acronym, abbreviation or proper name), you can use the **Add word** feature.

IMPORTANT: Initially, your Spell Checker word list is stored in the cookies area of your browser allowing for fast access to your word list. Because your word list is stored in your browser cookies, please note the following:

- If you change browsers, your dictionary will not contain words you added while using the spell checker in a different browser.
- If you clear cookies in your browser, this action also clears your Spell Checker word list.
- Cookies are limited in size, so if your dictionary grows in size past the limitations of your browser cookie storage, your dictionary may be saved on our server. The dictionary feature is only accessed once the limit for the cookies in your browser is reached.
- To create a dictionary, please use the steps below.

1. To create your dictionary, click **Options**.



2. Type a name for your dictionary, then click **Create**.

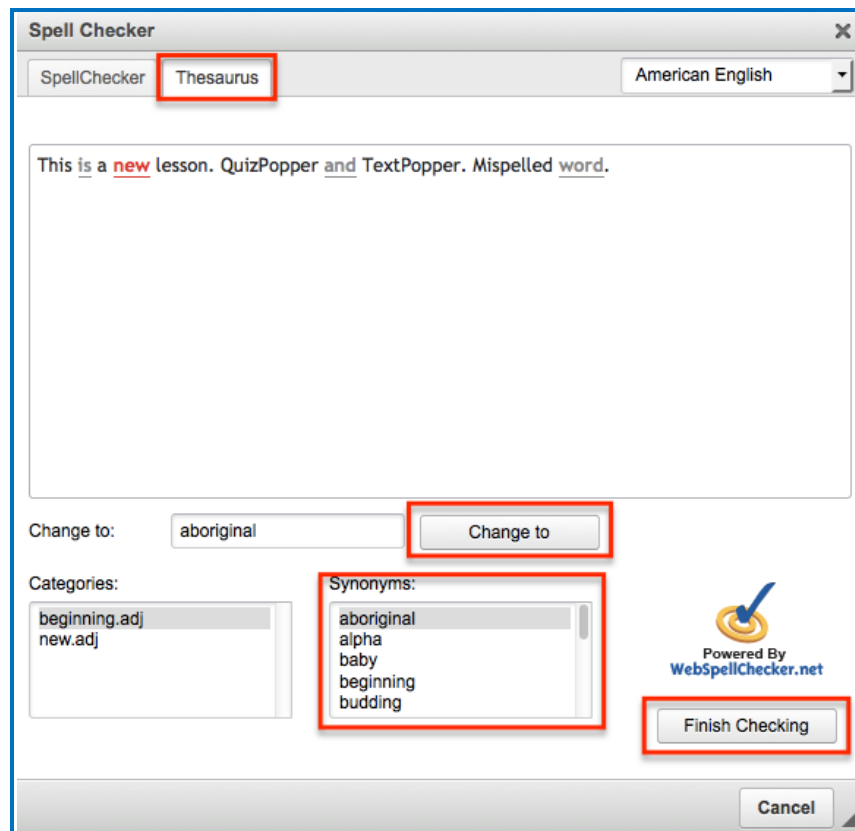

Use the Thesaurus

The Thesaurus feature is a part of the Spell Checker tool. It offers suggested synonyms for commonly used words. To use the Thesaurus, click the Spell Checker tool and follow the steps below.

1. Click the **Thesaurus** tab.
2. In the **Categories** area, select the category for the word you are looking to replace.
3. In the **Synonyms** area, select the synonym you wish to use.
4. Click **Change to**.
5. Click **Finish Checking** to save the change.



Open in Create Link

If your device and browser supports the ability to open SoftChalk Create from your browser, you will see an Open in Create link.

If you click this link, your lesson will be saved to the Cloud, Create Online will be closed (you'll return to your lesson details page) and SoftChalk Create will launch with your lesson open.

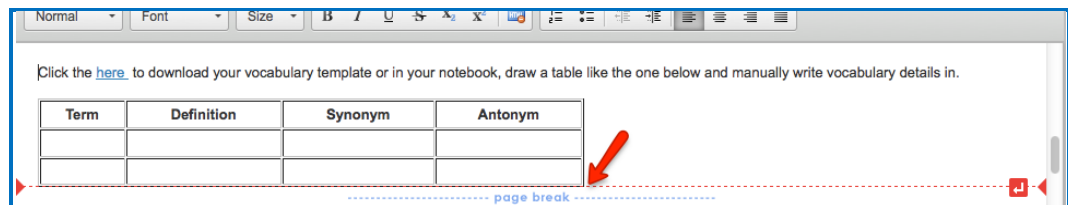

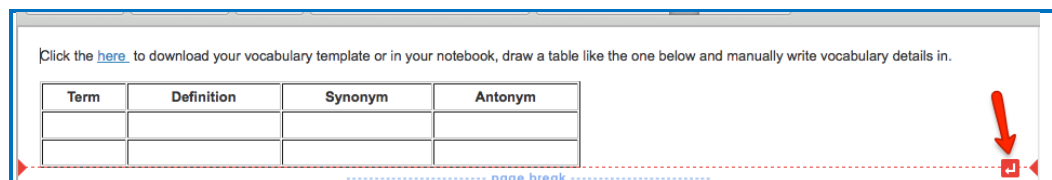

Notes About Using Create Online

- As mentioned earlier, Create Online is a feature which allows you to make basic lesson edits directly in your browser. If you want to build QuizPoppers, Activities, and other interactive elements, use SoftChalk Create (see the section [Start SoftChalk Create](#)).

(While currently the ability to add the above interactive elements in Create Online is unavailable, we will continue to add new features to Create Online over time, so stay tuned for future updates!)

- Style colors that were applied in SoftChalk Create will not appear in headings and tables, etc. when editing in Create Online. (At this time, lesson styles cannot be applied using Create Online.) The styles are retained, however, and will be visible when previewing the lesson in your browser.
- If you create a table using Create Online, initially it will appear with black colors. Later, you can modify the table in SoftChalk Create to use the styled table feature to match the style for your lesson - see the section [Start SoftChalk Create](#).
- Do not copy and paste QuizPoppers, Quiz Groups and Activities from one lesson to another. They each have identifying ID numbers specific to a lesson. If you open your lesson in SoftChalk Create, you can save an Activity or Quiz Group to your Learning Objects in your Cloud account and then insert that object in another lesson using SoftChalk Create. For details, see the section [Save a Learning Object or Quiz Group to the Cloud](#).
- For lessons that were created in SoftChalk Create 8, you can make edits in Create Online and save. At that point, the lesson is a Create 9 lesson and will no longer be editable in Create 8 (just like other Create 9 lessons).
- Lessons created in SoftChalk Create version 6 or 7 cannot be opened in Create Online. (You can open and save these lessons using the most current version of SoftChalk Create and then they will be editable with Create Online.)
- You can edit a lesson in Create Online and then edit it in SoftChalk Create and vice-versa. Just be sure to save your changes wherever you are working and close out the program you are *not* using to avoid confusion.
- While we do not recommend opening the same lesson in multiple tabs in Create Online, you can open multiple lessons in Create Online each in a different browser tab.

Manage Content

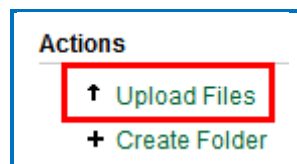
Upload Files

You can upload files directly from within your SoftChalk Cloud account. You can upload individual files or you can upload complex files (i.e. a .zip package of files) that you created in a program like Camtasia or Articulate.

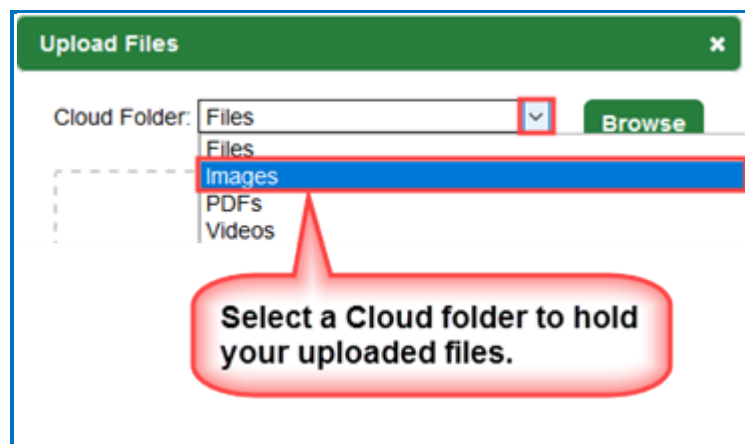
Once you upload a file or .zip package, you can use the SoftChalk Create program (see the section [Start SoftChalk Create](#)) to reference this file or .zip package in a lesson or multiple lessons. Within Create, you would choose **Insert/SoftChalk Cloud Item**.

If you need to update the file or .zip package, you can update it in one place in your Cloud **Files/Upload** files area. Below are the steps for putting files in your SoftChalk Cloud account. (For information on replacing a file or .zip package, see the section [Replace a File](#).)

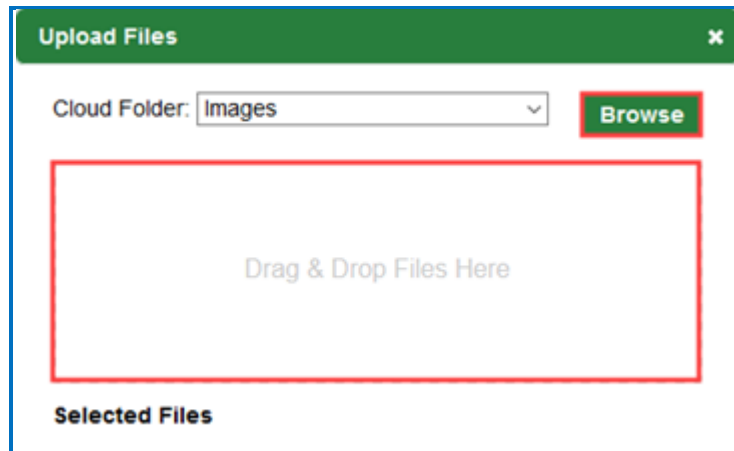
1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Select **My Content/Files**.
3. At the right under **Actions**, click **Upload Files**.



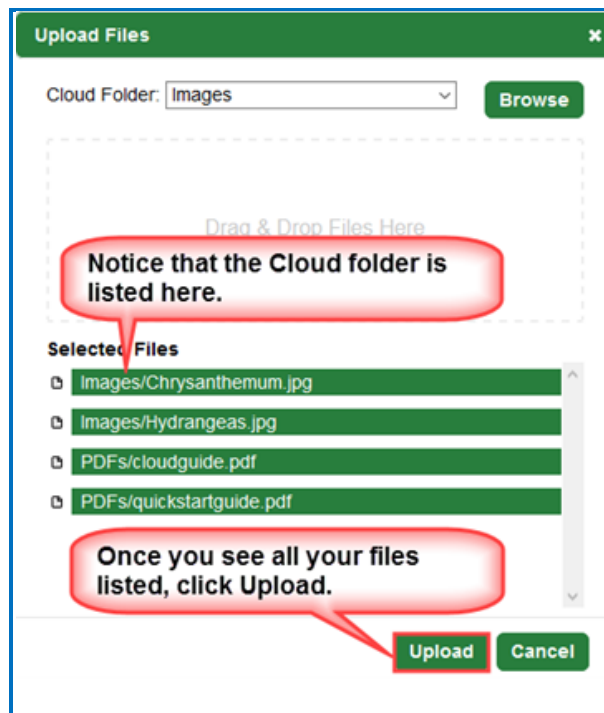

Re-arrange Content by Dragging


There are two methods to change the order of your items – dragging (see below) and sorting alphabetically (see the next section [Re-arrange Content by Sorting Alphabetically](#).)

You can re-arrange both the order of folders and the order of items within a folder by dragging with one exception. If you are in a section within the **My Content** area, **you cannot move a folder ABOVE the initial folder**. In other words, you cannot move a folder ABOVE the My Learning Objects folder, the My Lessons & Courses folder, the My Polls folder, the My Ratings folder or the My Files folder.

Move your cursor over the name of your item. When you get the cross icon , drag up or down to change the order of your items.



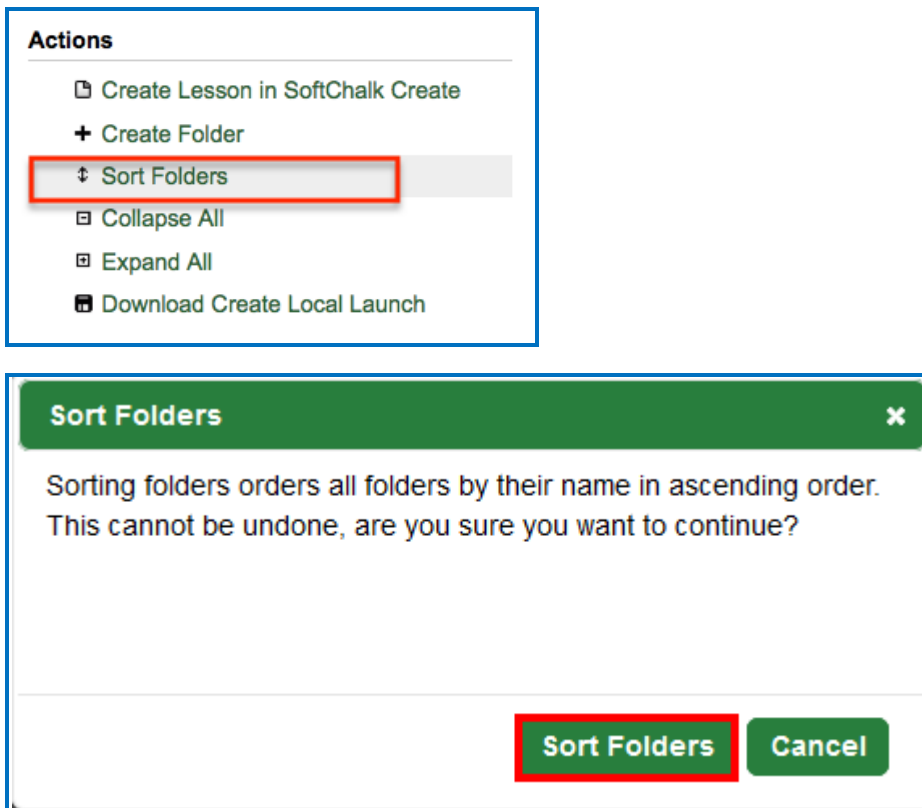

Re-arrange Content by Sorting Alphabetically

You can quickly sort by Name. For instance, in the **My Content/My Lessons & Courses** area under the **Actions** menu at the right (see below), click **Sort Folders**. Click **Sort Folders** at the confirmation screen.

(As mentioned previously, other areas besides **My Lessons & Courses** within [SoftChalk Cloud](#) may have a **Sort** option under the **Actions** menu at the right.)

If you sort by name, afterwards you can drag and change the order using the previous method ([Re-arrange Content by Dragging](#)).



Select a Previous Version of Your Content

As mentioned previously, within [SoftChalk Create](#) you can save your SoftChalk content (either a lesson, activities or quiz group) to [SoftChalk Cloud](#).

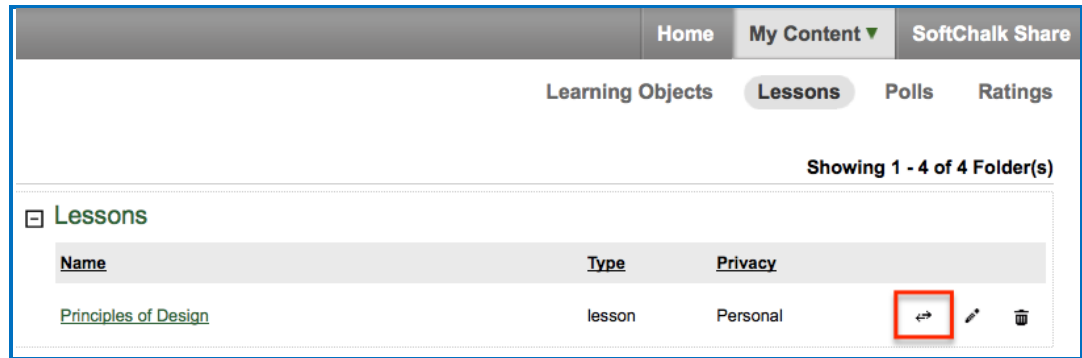
You can replace your item, but [SoftChalk Cloud](#) remembers your previous five versions of the item.

By default, the last version you save is your current version. By “**current version**” we mean the version that is available when:

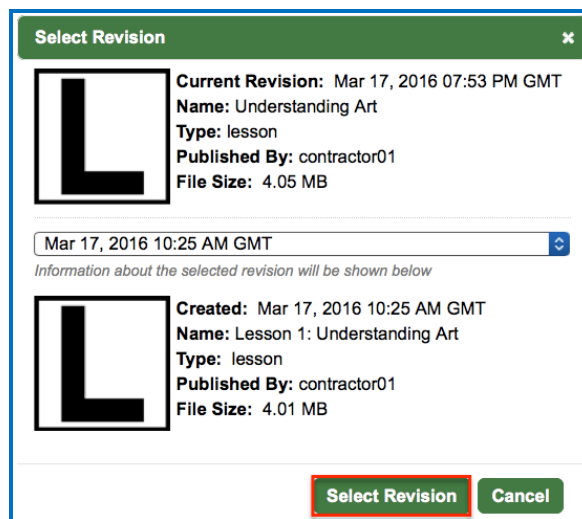
- Accessing the content with an embed code, hyperlink or LTI hyperlink.
- Clicking on the name of the item within the **My Content** area.
- Opening the item within the [SoftChalk Create File/Open from SoftChalk Cloud](#).

With a SoftChalk Cloud Account (or free 30-day trial SoftChalk account), however, you can select a previous version as your current version. (The instructions below show changing the version of a lesson but the same steps apply to changing the version of a Learning Object (**My Content/Learning Objects**)).

1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Click the **My Content/Lessons**.
3. Locate your item and click the **Select Revision** icon for it.



4. The **Current Revision** is listed at the top. Select a different revision from the dropdown menu. Click **Select Revision** to save your change.

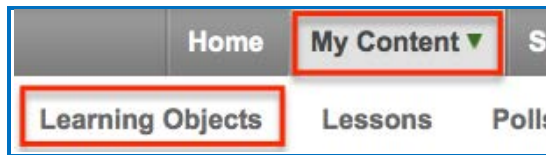


View, Edit Properties and Delete Your Content

After you save an item, you can view, edit properties for your item or delete your item from the [SoftChalk Cloud](#). (The steps below apply to Lessons as well as Learning Objects.) **Please note the following IMPORTANT comment concerning editing the properties for your items.**

IMPORTANT: If you re-save your item back to the Cloud, whatever **Metadata** you have for your item, will replace the properties you modified in the Cloud. (When you save an item to the Cloud, you will see a **Metadata** button on the Save screen.)

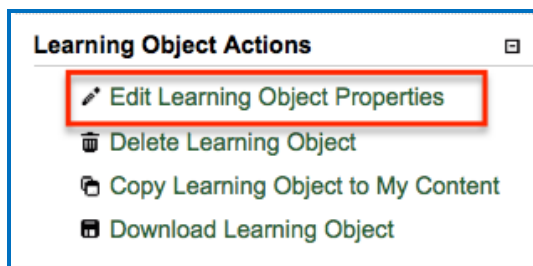
1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Click **My Content/Learning Objects**.



3. Under the **Name** column, locate your learning object and click on its link to view it. When viewing it, you are seeing and using the learning object as other users would view it. Once you click on the link (see below), you can also click **Preview** to view the learning object in a new window.



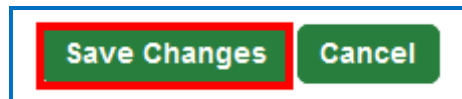
4. At the right under **Learning Object Actions**, click **Editing Learning Object Properties**.



5. **IMPORTANT:** Notice when you are editing properties, you are editing the information associated with the learning object and NOT the learning object itself. *To edit the learning object itself, you must use **SoftChalk Create**.* (See the section [Edit Your Content](#).)

As mentioned previously, if you re-save your item back to the Cloud, whatever **Metadata** you have for your item, will replace the properties you modified in the Cloud.

6. **IMPORTANT:** When you *edit the information for a learning object*, be sure to click **Save Changes** (at the top or bottom of your screen – see below).



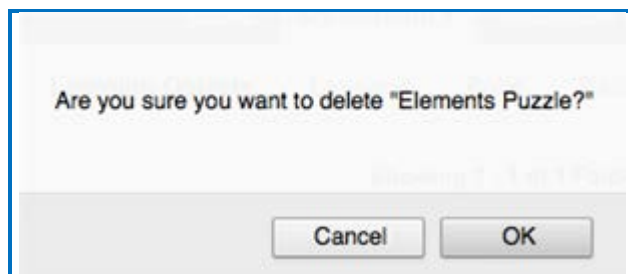
7. On the **Edit Properties** screen, you can edit the **Name**, **Description**, **Privacy** access and **License** information. For details on privacy options and licensing options, see the sections [Privacy Options](#) and [Creative Commons Licenses](#).

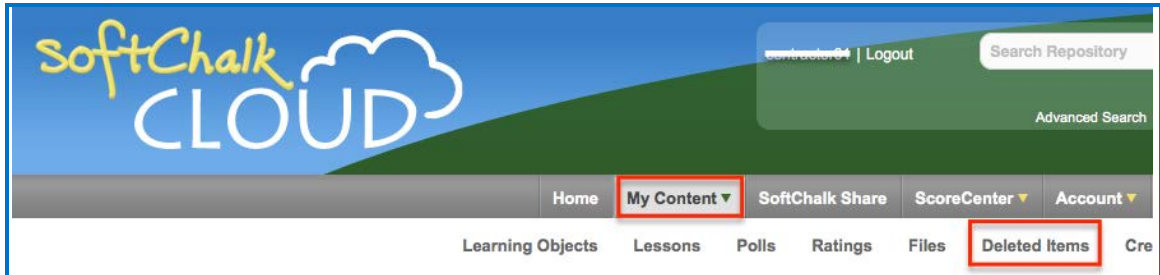





Restore Deleted Items

You will see any lesson, learning object, poll or file you have deleted within the past 30 days listed here. Once you find the lesson you would like to restore please select the **circular arrows** button shown below.

- Lesson - it will be restored to your **My Content/Lessons /Lessons** area.
- File - it will be restored to your **My Content/Files /Files** area.
- Learning Object - it will be restored to your **My Content/Learning Objects /Learning Objects** area.

Create eBooks

Overview

With a SoftChalk Cloud account, you now have the ability to use the same SoftChalk lessons for distributing your content online and offline. In other words, you can use the same SoftChalk lesson as a web-based lesson and as an eBook. With eBooks, students who ride buses or who have no internet service at home can benefit from the engaging, interactive content of your SoftChalk lessons without being connected to the internet.

The steps are easy to create and update eBooks. Once an eBook has been created within your SoftChalk Cloud account, you then distribute the hyperlink to this file to your students. They will open your eBook in the free SoftChalk eReader app, which is available for:

- iOS devices (iPads and iPhones)
- Android devices
- Chromebooks
- Chrome browser
- Windows computers

IMPORTANT: Be sure to save your lessons using *Create 10.01.04 or higher*.

IMPORTANT: See the **View Your Lesson as an eBook** section in the [Student Guide to SoftChalk Lessons](#) for instructions on installing and using the free *SoftChalk eReader app*. The link to install the free SoftChalk eReaders can be found at: <http://softchalk.com/ebookreader>.

Use Version Numbers and Revision Dates in Your eBook

We recommend using version numbers and/or revision dates for your eBook either as content on the first page of your lesson or as part of the title for your eBook. That way, if you update your eBook, you can tell your students to double-check that they have the revised eBook, for instance, **Version 3 updated on December 10, 2016**.

Format Your Lesson for the eBook

You can use the same SoftChalk lesson to deliver content in a web browser or as an eBook. As you develop your lessons, please be aware of the inherent differences between viewing the lesson in a web browser and reading an eBook. A web page has the capability for unlimited scrolling while an eBook page has a fixed dimension. Since SoftChalk lessons can include activities and quiz items, please review your eBook to observe the page breaks, making sure your content flows well. Also, you may need to shorten the width of your tables to have them fit into the eBooks dimensions.

In short, if you plan on delivering your lesson to your students as both a web-based lesson and as an eBook, then we recommend that you format your lesson for the eBook. If you already have SoftChalk lessons that you want to

use as eBooks, you may need to make adjustments to the lesson to make it flow as an eBook.

Styles

The style for your lesson needs to be a Banner style, Personal style or Custom style (i.e. a style purchased by your institution).

IMPORTANT: Non-styled lessons and lessons with Basic styles do not work in eBooks. (Within the SoftChalk lesson, choose **Properties/Style Properties**. On the **Styles** tab, select a style at the right that is NOT a Basic style.)

Activities and QuizPoppers

- Activities and QuizPoppers will always display as a pop up from an icon if they are embedded in lesson pages.
- Quiz Groups will always display questions as a pop up from an icon, even if they are embedded in lesson pages. You may want to consider using the display one at a time option for the best appearance. If you choose not to use this option, the questions will appear in a scrolling window.
- Essay questions are not supported. (There is no way to capture the student answers).

Scores and Essays Are Not Captured

While there is no mechanism for capturing scores or essays in an eBook, students can use eBooks lessons for “practice scores.” In other words, you can assign points to activities and quiz items. As your students view your lessons, they can complete items and see scores.

Since scores and essays are not captured, ***you cannot use the following features in eBooks.*** (These features are set within the SoftChalk Create lesson under **File/Package Lesson**.)

- Print Certificate of Completion
- Print Score Summary
- Email Completion Results

Headings

We recommend that you use headings in your lessons. To create a heading when editing a SoftChalk lesson, click within a line of text and at the upper right of the screen, click the dropdown arrow beside Plain Text to select a heading: Heading 1, Heading 1 Designer, Heading 2, Heading 2 Designer, Heading 3, or Heading 3 Designer.

Page Breaks

Page breaks from your lesson are recognized by the eReader. In the example below, the SoftChalk lesson for this eBook contained page breaks before each main heading (Jefferson Overview, Drafting the Declaration, President). As you can see, these page breaks are recognized as the eBook is presented in the eReader.

Please be aware that the number of pages in your web-based lesson may not correspond to the number of pages in your eBook. For instance, the first page of your lesson may be really long and comprise two pages in your eBook. If you are planning to create eBooks from your lessons, you may want to keep the content on each page short.



Table of Contents

You can use the Table of Contents icon within the SoftChalk eReader with the Page Names feature. If you use Page Names for your lesson (see the next section [Create Page Names in Your Lesson](#)), these names will appear in the eBook Table of Contents.

For details on viewing the table of contents, see the **View Your Lesson as an eBook** section in the [Student Guide to SoftChalk Lessons](#).

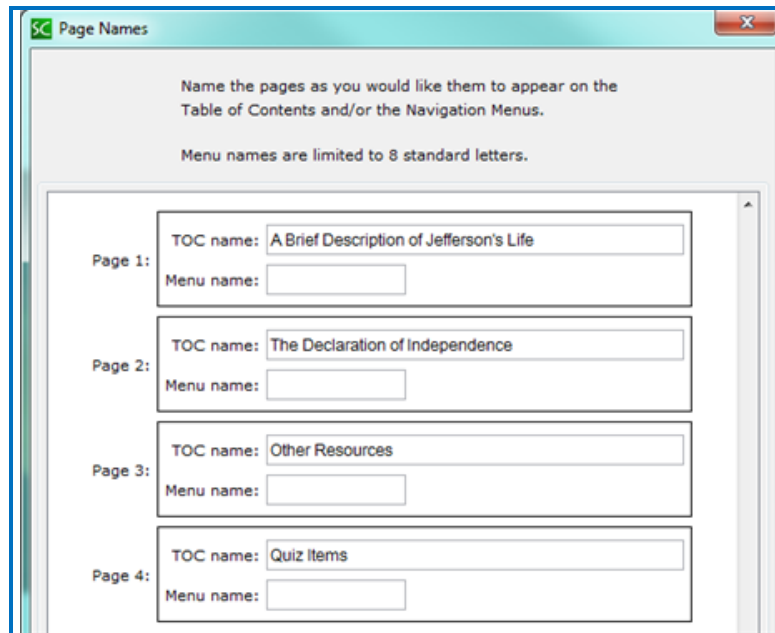
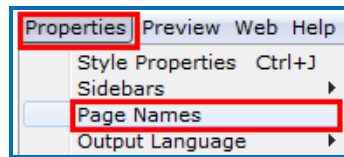
Please note: If you use a Table of Contents page in your lesson (selected from **Properties/Style Properties/Title and Layout** tab within your Create lesson), that Table of Contents entry page will not appear in your eBook.

Create Page Names in Your Lesson

As mentioned previously, if you use Page Names in your lesson, they will appear in the Table of Contents for your eBook.

1. Start the SoftChalk Create application and create or edit a lesson. (Within your Cloud account, choose **My Content/Create Content**. If you need more information on using the SoftChalk Create program, please see the [SoftChalk Create Guide](#)).

2. Choose **Properties/Page Names** and enter your Page Names. (To have multiple page names, you can insert page breaks within your lesson – **Insert/Page Break**.)



3. As previously mentioned, we also recommend that you *use headings in your lesson*.
4. Save your lesson to SoftChalk Cloud. Within your lesson, choose **File**, then **Save to SoftChalk Cloud**.

Sidebars

Sidebars are not supported in the eReader.

Tables

As mentioned previously, you may need to shorten the widths of your tables to have them fit on an eBook.

Bookmarks

Bookmarks function as external links in SoftChalk eBooks. Let's say you have inserted and linked to a bookmark within your lesson (Insert/Bookmark and then created a hyperlink to the bookmark). In an eBook, clicking on this bookmark link will open the hyperlink for the lesson in the web browser and take you to the bookmark in the lesson.

TextPoppers

TextPoppers in eBooks will function as tooltips in eBooks and have a maximum width allotted to them. In other words, when you move over a TextPopper, a tooltip will appear below it.

Below is a description of how content from your TextPoppers may appear in your eBook. We recommend you experiment and see what works best for your content.

Images

- Because of the maximum width of the tooltip and depending on the width of your images, your images may exceed the boundary of the maximum width for the tooltip. (Your images may be present but overflow the border for the tooltip.)
- If you inserted a reference link to an image for a SoftChalk Cloud item, it will appear if the student is online when viewing your eBook.

Equations – The images comments above apply to equations as well.

Media – (audio and video) not supported within TextPoppers.

Hyperlinks – Hyperlinks should appear in the device's browser window when clicked on.

Background style TextPoppers (Flower, Oval, Speech, Quotation, Thought, Postit and Pushpin) - are not supported

The following TextPopper values will be irrelevant when creating an eBook:

Position – The position of the tooltip appears directly below your TextPopper.

Width of TextPopper – A maximum width is allotted by default.

YouTube Videos

If you used the standard method for putting a YouTube video in your SoftChalk lesson (either finding it through the **Tools/Media Search** tool or choosing **Insert/Widget** and pasting in the HTML), then your YouTube videos should work fine in your eBooks. (Of course, you have to be online for the YouTube videos to appear.)

iFrames with PDF Files

You will need to be online to access iframes within an eBook. In creating your lesson, if you put an attachment such as a PDF into an iFrame in your lesson, you will see this iFrame converted to the following within the eBook.

To view the link, click [here](#).

Once you click the link, your browser will open for you to view the attachment.

iFrames with URLs

If you have iFrames with URLs, you may want to consider using hyperlinks that open in a new window instead.

For the following eReaders, an iFrame with a URL will display the website within the page of the eBook. (Of course, you have to be online for the websites to appear.) Just fyi, there are some websites that automatically launch the website in a browser window, but a website such as <https://softchalkcloud.com> is viewable within an iFrame for the eReaders below.)

If your students will be viewing on smaller (mini) devices, you may want to test the dimensions of your iFrame and see how it works.

- Android SoftChalk eReader
- Chrome SoftChalk eReader
- Windows SoftChalk eReader

For the iOS SoftChalk eReader (iPad and iPhone), if you go to a page in your eBook that has an iFrame with a website, your web browser is automatically launched taking you to the website for the URL. If your students will be using iPads, then we recommend you use hyperlinks to websites rather than iFrames.

Hyperlinks to Files

You may have created a hyperlink to a file in your lesson (In other words, within your Create lesson, you selected some text, chose hyperlink and then chose the **Select File** button to select a file). To use these hyperlinks to files in your eBook, you will need to be online. The file will be launched from a web browser.

Audio and Video

As always when using media, you need to be aware of the devices that your users may have. We recommend formats such as .mp3 for audio and .mp4 for video as those formats are used widely on various devices and web browsers.

There are several ways to have audio and video in your SoftChalk lesson.

IMPORTANT: For all the options below, you would need to be online to access your media in an eBook.

Put your media in SoftChalk Cloud – Within your SoftChalk Cloud account, you can upload files to the Content/Files area. The file can be a single file or complex files (i.e. a zip package containing a Camtasia or Articulate project).

- For details, see the section [Upload Files](#).
- When you create your lesson in SoftChalk Create, to link or insert this media into your lesson, you can choose **Insert/SoftChalk Cloud Item**. Then you can choose the reference on Cloud option. If you happen to choose the **Include file with lesson** option, you would still need to be online to access the media in an eBook.

Widget – Put your media on a streaming media server at your institution. When you create your lesson, use the **Insert/Widget** option and paste the HTML code for your media.

Insert/Media – Most of the time we recommend using the first two options above because those options will keep your lesson size small and the lesson loading time faster. If you decide, however, to use the **Insert/Media** feature within SoftChalk Create to add media files that way, we support the **Linked file** option. (The inline player option is not supported.)

Insert SoftChalk Cloud Item


When creating your lesson if you used the **Insert / SoftChalk Cloud Item** feature to link to content in your Cloud account, this content is displayed as follows.

Of course for all the options below you need to be online.

- Images appear within the pages
- Audio and Video – you click on an icon, which opens your browser and takes you to <https://softchalkcloud.com> to play your file
- For files like PDFs and Word documents, you click on a link to the file, which opens your browser and takes you to <https://softchalkcloud.com> to view or download the file. (Viewing or downloading the file depends on how your browser is configured to handle different file types.)

Create a New eBook

1. Be sure to see the previous section [Best Practices for Creating eBooks](#) for tips on formatting your lessons for eBooks. **IMPORTANT:** As mentioned previously, be sure to save your lessons using **Create 10.01.04 or higher**.
2. Log into your SoftChalk Cloud account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
3. Go to **My Content/Lessons**.
4. To the right of each lesson title, you will see an icon that represents the eBook status of your lesson.





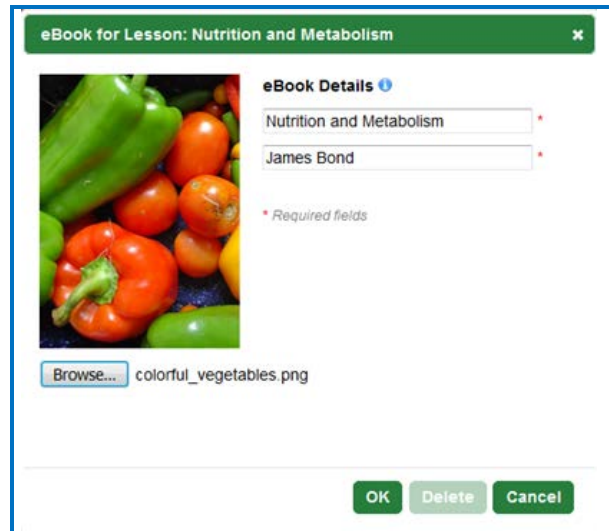

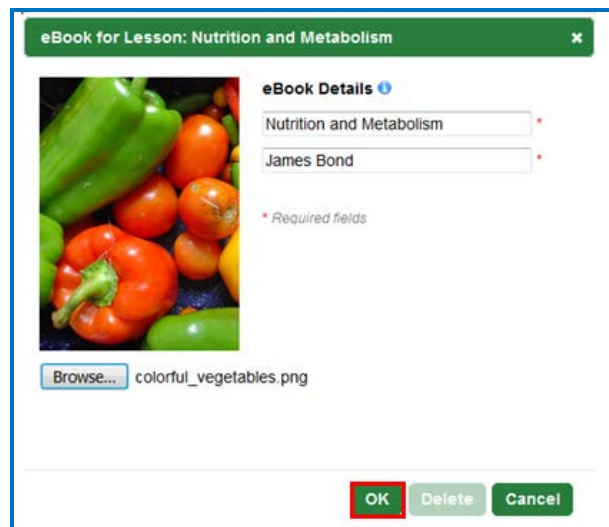
- The Create eBook window will pop-up allowing you to select eBook details. By default, the title is the Cloud name for your lesson and the Author is your first and last name from your SoftChalk Cloud account. Both of these fields are editable but are required.

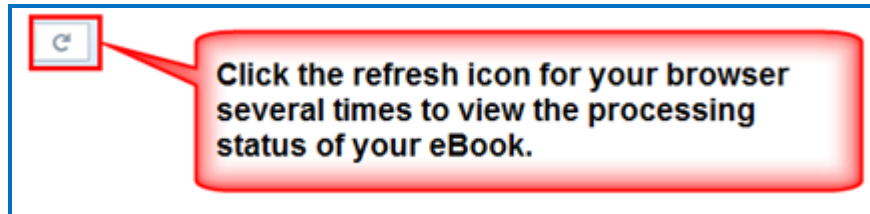
- Using a cover image is optional. Click **Browse** to select a file or drag over a file. The recommended size is 875 X 1200. (There is a maximum size limit of 500 MB, so you may want to use a .jpg format for your image if you have a photo.) If you don't use a cover page, the SoftChalk eReader will automatically "assign" a cover page to your book.
- Once you have made all your selections, click the **OK** button to save the eBook.

9. A couple of messages will appear that your eBook is processing and then you will be returned to your list of lessons or the Lessons actions area.

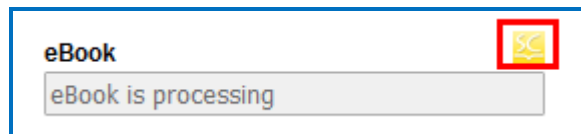
IMPORTANT: Click the refresh icon for your browser several times to view the processing status of your eBook.



10. Depending on the size of your lesson, the eBook may take a few seconds or a couple of minutes to process. While processing, the eBook status icon next to your lesson name (in your list of lessons) will be yellow instead of gray, indicating that the eBook is processing. (For the status of eBooks, please [see the description of all eBook status icons.](#))

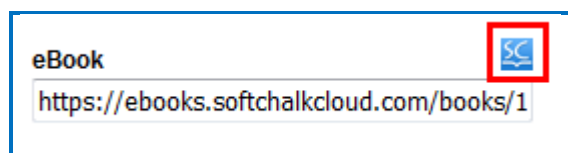

When you first view your eBook in a web browser, you may need to refresh the browser window to view the book cover.

As previously mentioned, if you are looking at your lesson list, you can click the blue icon to view your eBook in a web browser.

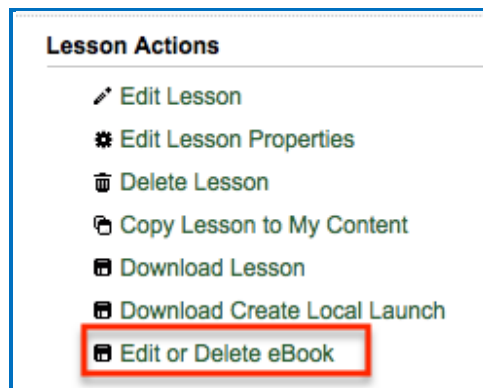

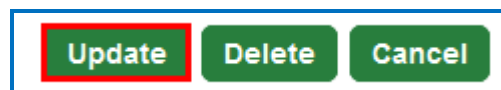

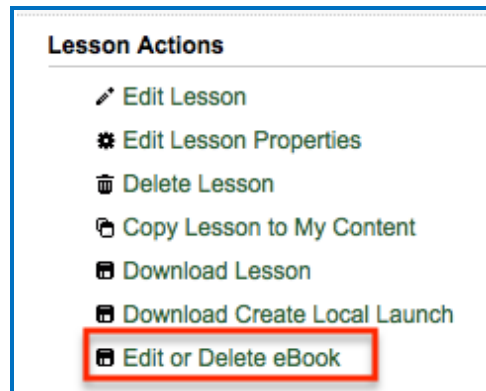


IMPORTANT: When you update your eBook, students will be notified automatically when they click the refresh button on the eReader. Then, they can click **Update** and download the updated eBook. Due to the nature of eBooks, annotations (bookmarks, comments and highlights) are NOT kept when an eBook is updated. Delete an eBook

Deleting an eBook from the Cloud only makes the URL for the eBook inoperative. A student would still have the eBook on their device until they delete it.

1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)). Go to **My Content/Lessons** and click your lesson name.
2. Under the **Lesson Actions** menu, click **Edit or Delete eBook**.



3. Click **Delete**. For the delete confirmation screen, click **OK**. If you return back to your Lesson list, you will notice that icon for your eBook has reverted to gray.

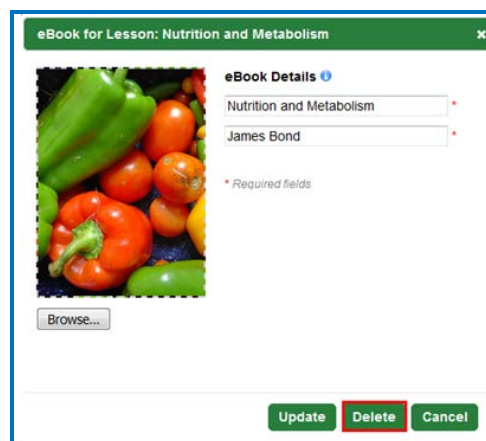

3. Copy the link and provide it to your students.

- Blank pages in the eBook may be the result of changing the font size within the eReader app.
- The font for the eBook is currently Times New Roman for the general text in the lesson.
- There is no SoftChalk eReader app for the Kindle as this device does not support the epub3 format upon which SoftChalk eBooks are based.
- Your eBook link MAY work in other eBook reader applications such as iBooks or Radium, but SoftChalk does not officially support these other eBook reader applications. We suggest you have your students use our free SoftChalk eReader app instead.
- Be sure you are always using the most updated version of the SoftChalk eReader app. You should be able to get updates for the app as you would any other app on your device. (For the Windows eReader, you can uninstall the app, download the current installer and install the new Windows eReader.)

- Create a lesson with [SoftChalk Create](#) and save it in [SoftChalk Cloud](#).
- [If you are using the ScoreCenter feature within your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account to collect student scores, be sure to set up your ScoreCenter first. See the section [Track Student Scores OUTSIDE an LMS \(ScoreCenter\)](#)]
- Copy the Hyperlink for your lesson or the LTI Link if you are integrating the lesson with your learning management system gradebook.
- Paste the Hyperlink or LTI Link in your courses. (Pasting in the LTI Link is NOT the same process as pasting in a plain hyperlink. See the section [Learning Management System Guides](#).)
- When you update the lesson in [SoftChalk Cloud](#), the lesson will update in your multiple courses and learning management systems because you are using Hyperlinks or LTI Links.

Track Student Scores WITHIN Your LMS (ScoreCenter and LTI)

Depending on your learning management system, there are different options to collect scores within your learning management system - see the next two sections – [Explanation of ScoreCenter and LTI Features](#) and [Learning Management System Guides](#)).

Explanation of ScoreCenter and LTI Feature

The ScoreCenter and LTI feature is available for certain learning management systems (see the next section [Learning Management System Guides](#)). The ScoreCenter and LTI feature allows instructors to collect detailed scoring information from SoftChalk lessons within the gradebook area of the LMS. In order to use the LTI feature, learning management system administrators need to configure their LMS to enable the LTI feature. (For details, see the next section [Learning Management System Guides](#).) **IMPORTANT NOTE FOR LMS Administrators:** If you plan to use the LTI feature, you must have you must have **LTI 1.1 or higher**.

As an instructor, the LTI feature allows you to:

- Save lessons in your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account
- Copy an LTI Link for a lesson (see the section [Copy the LTI Link for Your Lesson](#)). **IMPORTANT:** Be sure to copy the LTI Link (and NOT the Hyperlink).
- Paste the LTI hyperlink into your course(s) within your learning management system(s). (Pasting in the LTI Link is NOT the same process as pasting in a normal hyperlink. See the section [Learning Management System Guides](#).)
- Set the properties for the lesson in your LMS. See the section [Learning Management System Guides](#). For instance, you would set the grading method (first score, most recent score, highest score or average score). In other words, all the attempts are kept but you can determine how the grade is set for the lesson. You can also designate the number of attempts allowed (unlimited or a specific number).
- View and edit student scores within the LMS gradebook area. (This area links to the SoftChalk ScoreCenter. You can use all the features of the ScoreCenter – see the next section [Learning Management System Guides](#) for a guide to your learning management system.)
- Students can view their scores as they normally would within your LMS.
- Update the lessons in one place. (Replace the lesson within your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account – see the section [Edit a Lesson](#).) The content updates in your course(s) and learning management system(s) because you have an LTI link to it.

Overview

If your institution does not have a learning management system, you may want to track student scores with the ScoreCenter feature within [SoftChalk Cloud](#). (If your institution HAS a learning management system but it does NOT support the LTI feature (see below), you may also want to use the ScoreCenter feature within [SoftChalk Cloud](#).) The ScoreCenter feature lets you collect detailed scoring information for students who take your SoftChalk lessons (developed in [SoftChalk Create](#)). Within your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account, you can set up various ScoreCenters and designate lessons to be tracked (i.e. collect student scores from these lessons). You can choose to share this scoring information with other instructors as well as download these scores.

[If your institution HAS a learning management system that supports the LTI feature, then you can collect student scores WITHIN your learning management systems gradebook. See the section [Track Student Scores WITHIN an LMS \(ScoreCenter and LTI\)](#).]

Deliver ScoreCenter Lessons to Your Students

A “ScoreCenter lesson” is a SoftChalk lesson that you have chosen to track within a ScoreCenter (see the section [Tracked Lessons](#)). Complete All Attempts for a Lesson

You may find that your students have neglected to complete their attempts (i.e. they have neglected to click **Finish** on the last page of the lesson – clicking Finish sends a completion status to the gradebook).

- If an attempt is COMPLETED, then the score from the attempt is calculated to determine a student's grade for the lesson (e.g. first attempt, average of the attempts, most recent attempt and highest attempt).
- If an attempt is INCOMPLETE, the score from the incomplete attempt is not part of the grade calculation.

(As noted previously, you can set the number of attempts for a lesson – see the section [Set the Maximum Number of Attempts for a Lesson.](#))

If you want to change the status to complete for incomplete attempts, you have two options. You can:

Using Essays with a ScoreCenter

Create the Essay Question and Assign Points

You can create essay questions within [SoftChalk Create](#) (choose **Insert/QuizPopper/Essay**). If you like, you can assign points to your essay question. In this case, you would need to change the score for a lesson based on the points you want to give for the essay. For example, you may have a lesson worth 100 points including one essay worth 10 points. (You assigned the points under the **Options** tab for the essay and other items.) Let's say a student completes everything correctly, completes the essay, clicks the **Finish** button for the essay and then clicks the **Finish** button on the last page of the lesson to submit his or her score. At this stage, the student has a score of 90 out of 100 because you will need to evaluate the essay and assign points.

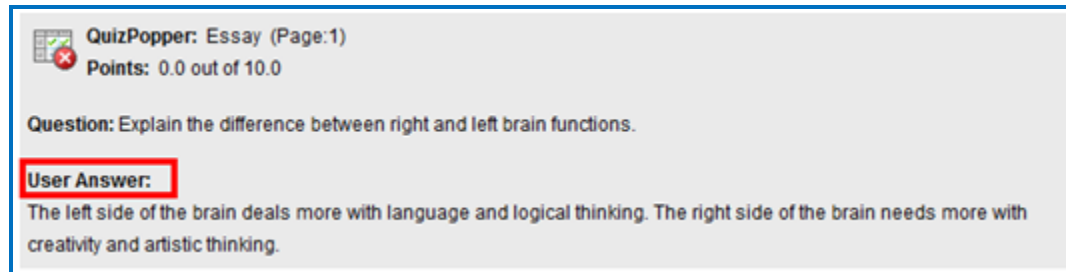

- Work on a distinct set of master lessons that can be modified for future semesters but not effect lessons in the current semester

Steps to Create Master Lessons

1. Log into your SoftChalk Cloud account.
2. Create a folder in **My Content/Lessons** called **Master Lessons**.
3. Create master lessons and put them into this folder.
4. When these lessons are ready to be “rolled out” for a particular semester, create a new folder in **My Content/Lessons**. Name this folder after the semester, for example, **2015 Spring Semester**.
5. Go back to the original **Master Lessons** folder. Click on the name of a lesson in this folder.
6. Scroll down to the **Lesson Actions** area and choose **Copy Lesson to My Content**.
7. At the top under **My Content/Lessons**.
8. Drag the copied lesson from the **Lessons** folder into your semester folder, for example, **2015 Spring Semester**.
9. Rename the lesson. (You could reference the semester name in the lesson name. This name is what you would see when you view the lesson in your Cloud account versus a title for the lesson that the student would see in a learning management system.)
10. Repeat for each lesson. (Copy the master lesson. Move it to your semester folder and rename the lesson.)
11. Copy the Hyperlink or LTI link for a lesson in the semester folder, for example, your **2015 Spring Semester**.

12. Paste this Hyperlink or LTI link into the **course template or course** in your learning management system. For details on pasting Hyperlinks or LTI Links into your learning management system, please see your learning management system guide for SoftChalk.
13. Repeat for each lesson. (Copy the current link for a lesson in your semester folder and paste it into your learning management system.)
14. If you are using a course template in your learning management system, you can copy this template to various courses.

IMPORTANT: If you are a Blackboard user and plan to copy courses that have LTI links, be sure to select the **Results Center, Columns and Settings** option when doing a course copy in Blackboard. SoftChalk Share

Overview

A public content repository called **SoftChalk Share** is part of the [SoftChalk Cloud](#). From the **SoftChalk Share** tab of [SoftChalk Cloud](#), the public (without a SoftChalk Cloud account) can search for content and get a hyperlink or embed code for a large volume of educational content. The public can search by:

- Keyword(s)
- Subject (e.g. math, science, language arts, music, etc.)
- Level (e.g. undergraduate, 12th grade, 11th grade, etc.)
- Type of content (learning object, quiz group and lesson)

Content on this site is governed by Creative Commons licensing (see the section [Creative Commons Licenses](#)).

As previously mentioned, users with a [SoftChalk Cloud account](#) have posted this content, which they produced with [SoftChalk Create](#). (SoftChalk Create is an eLearning content authoring program that is part of a [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account.)

Advantages of a SoftChalk Cloud Account

If the public can search SoftChalk Share and get hyperlinks to content, what are the advantages of having a SoftChalk Cloud account? With a [SoftChalk Cloud account](#) you can:

- Copy content you find through SoftChalk Share and modify it (see the sections [Modify Content that You Find](#)).
- **Have your content available wherever you have internet access** because you can log into your SoftChalk Cloud account and edit your lessons from anywhere.
- **Update a lesson once but link to this lesson in many places** such as multiple courses within your learning management system.
- **Collect grades using LTI links within your learning management system** if you have Angel, Blackboard, BrainHoney, Canvas, Desire2Learn, Jenzabar and Moodle.
- Collect grades outside of a learning management system using the ScoreCenter feature within your Cloud account.

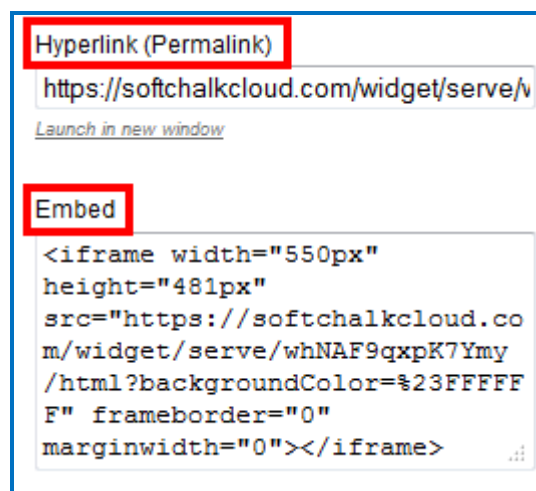
An **embed code** allows you to have the item appear within the context of your web page or SoftChalk lesson. In other words, the user will automatically see the item when the web page appears. 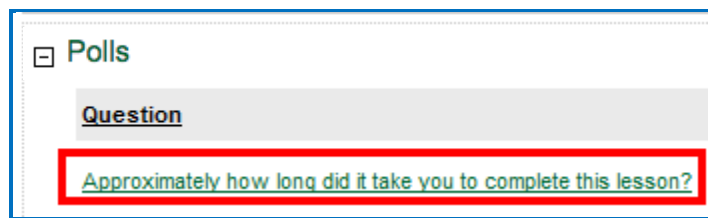


4. As mentioned previously, if you use a narrow dimension for your poll, you can insert the poll as a widget in a sidebar (see the explanation below).

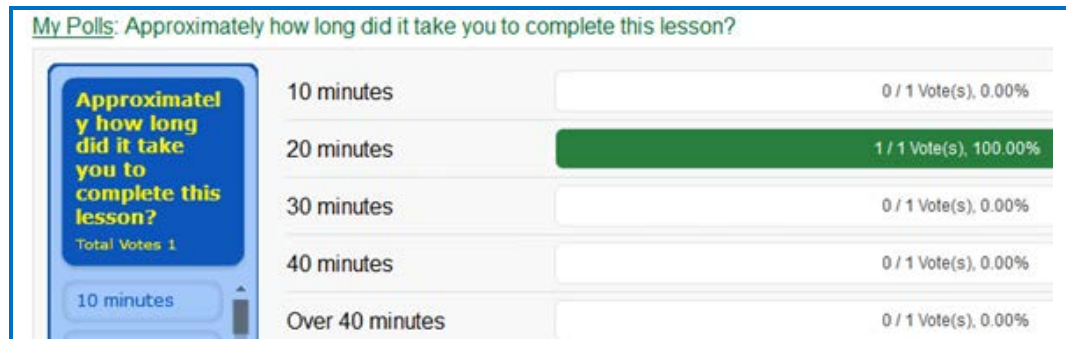

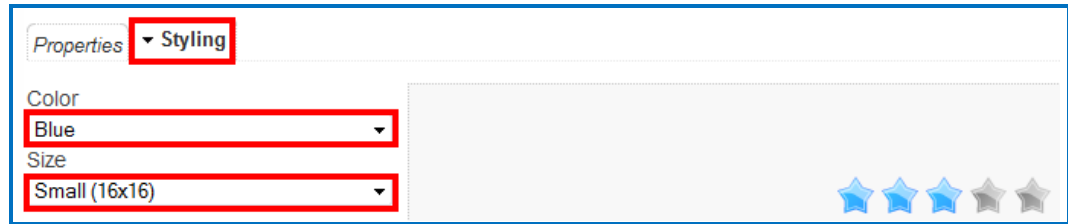

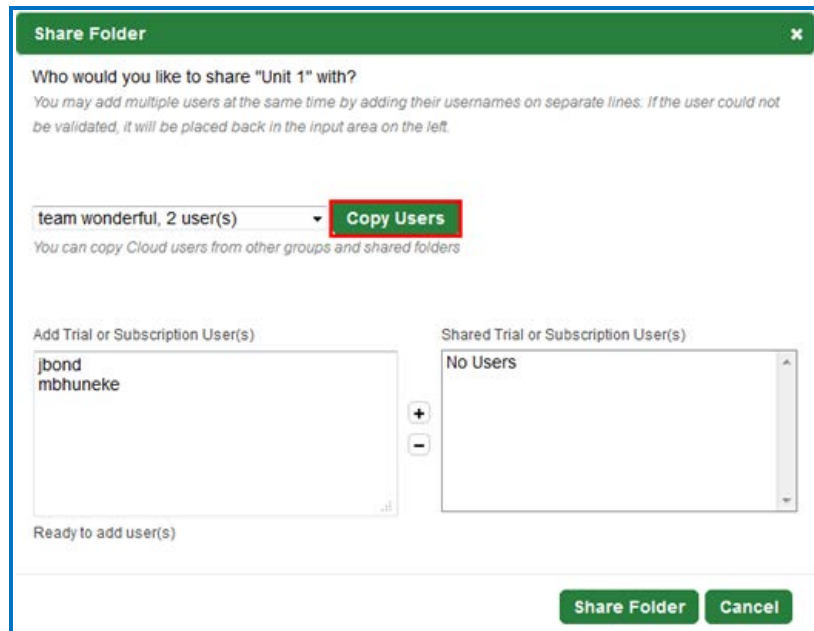
1. Log into your [SoftChalk Cloud](#) account (see the section [Log into Your Account](#)).
2. Click **My Content**. (If **My Content** is disabled, then you need to log in.) Click **Learning Objects**.
3. Create a folder if you haven't done so already by clicking **Create Folder** under the Actions menu at the right.


Report Inappropriate Content

Migrate Content from SoftChalk Desktop to SoftChalk Cloud

This section is for SoftChalk users who have the desktop version of SoftChalk and want to migrate their content to their SoftChalk Cloud accounts. When you migrate your content to SoftChalk Cloud, you will see many advantages to using SoftChalk Cloud:

- Your content is available wherever you have internet access because you can log into your SoftChalk Cloud account and edit your lesson from anywhere.
- You can update your lesson once but link to the lesson in many places such as multiple courses within your learning management system.
- You can collaborate with other instructors on lessons – see the section [Collaborate with Other Instructors on SoftChalk Lessons](#).

(You have the option to save your content to your local computer as well.)

Steps to Migrate Content

1. Create a SoftChalk Cloud account – see the section [Create an Account](#).
2. Start your desktop version of SoftChalk. (Double-click on your SoftChalk icon on your desktop.)
3. Save your lessons to SoftChalk Cloud. Within your desktop SoftChalk Create, choose **File/Manage Publish Accounts**. Click **New**. Click **OK** to accept SoftChalk Cloud. Type in your username and password and click **OK**. Open your lesson from your local computer. Choose **File/Save to SoftChalk Cloud** – see the section [Save a Lesson to the Cloud](#).
4. Edit your lessons within SoftChalk Cloud – see the section [Edit a Lesson](#).
5. Put content from your SoftChalk Library (desktop version) such as activities, quiz groups or images into SoftChalk Cloud.
 - a. Start your desktop version of SoftChalk. (Double-click on your SoftChalk icon on your desktop.)
 - b. Choose **Tools/Library**. At the left, select an item. At the right, select the **My Learning Objects** folder (or another folder you may have created).
 - c. At the left, select a privacy option such as **Personal** – see the section [Privacy Options](#).

- d. At the left, click **Save**. (If Save is disabled, you may have selected a single QuizPopper. You can only save a Quiz Group. Be sure to select a folder that contains only QuizPoppers.)
 - e. Click **Close** and **Close** to return to your main editing window.
 6. Your saved Library items appear within your SoftChalk Cloud account. Log into your SoftChalk Cloud account. Under **My Content/Learning Objects**, you will see your content.
 7. To insert or modify an item from your **My Content/Learning Objects** into a SoftChalk lesson, see the section [Insert and Modify a Learning Object or Quiz Group](#).
 8. To create folders and manage your content, see the section [Manage Content](#).
 9. To collaborate with other instructors on content, see the section [Collaborate with Other Instructors on SoftChalk Lessons](#).
